Property Description

Also known as Ta' Bachar Bastion. St Mary Bastion is a small irregular bulwark that was grafted onto the old medieval ramparts of Mdina. Eventually it was linked to Magazine Curtain. Its date of construction is unknown but it already appears in D'Aleccio's frescoes of the Great Siege, which means it must pre-date that event by a number of years. The bastion has two embrasures in its left flank designed to enfilade the adjoining curtain wall.


