

Property Description	Greek's Gate consists of two gate ways, one grafted in front of the other. The inner most gate is the old medieval entrance. This was a secondary gateway, or porta falsa as it was called , with its pointed arch, and led down into the ditch. The outer portal is a later Baroque construction dating from the early eighteenth century. It was constructed the French Military engineer Charles Francois de Mondion and was served by an a' la Vauban drawbridge and protected by a drop ditch, the latter no longer visible. Greeks gate was less ornate than the main gate and lacked a superstructure . Its corpo di guardia was located inside the passageway. It also contains a 'cantina' (underground chamber) for the retraction of the drawbridge platform.
