Outline Description Pentagonal Bastion

Property Description De Redin Bastion is the central bastion on the main land front of the fortress overlooking Rabat. It is a pentagonal-shaped bastion with an obtuse salient. It is the largest of Mdina's bastions and contains six embrasures on each of its two flanks and two embrasures in the middle of each of its two faces. The bastion has a sloping lower half and a high parapet. A small escutcheon or effigy was placed in a niche on the salient of the bastion. The bastion is a solid work and is approached through a casemate in the curtain wall to its rear.

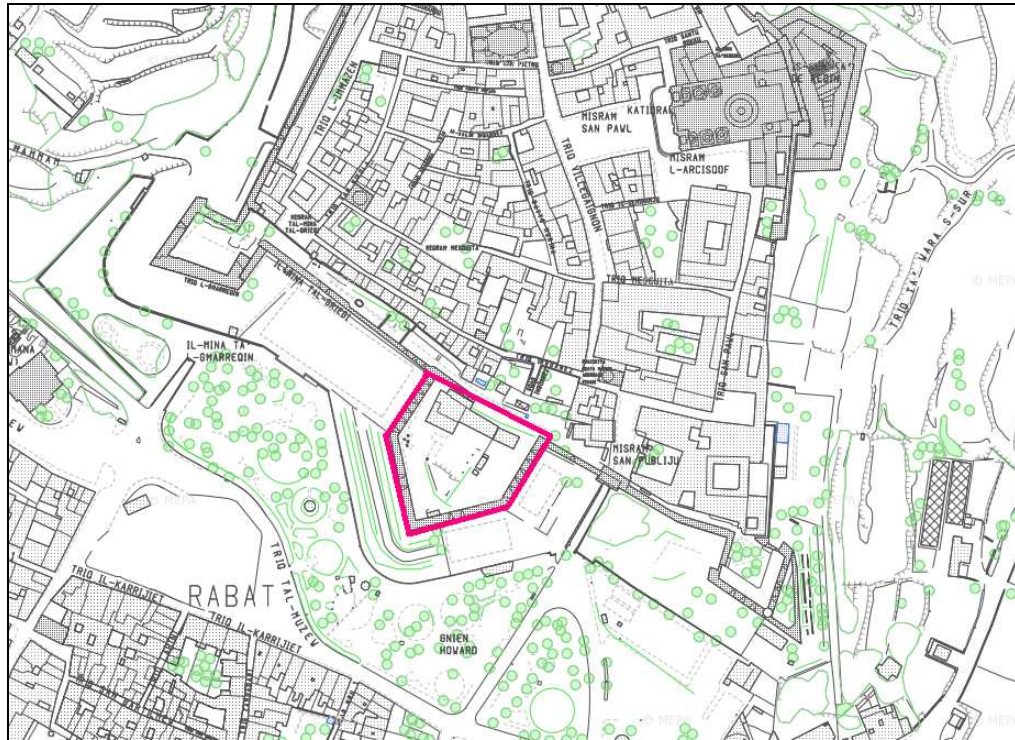
