Property Description Covered caponier linking sally-port to ditch and designed to provide a covered passage way to access the ravelin. Originally the caponier was an open passage of communication designed on the French pattern but this was roofed over on the early British period to create a double fighting caponier pierced with many musketry loopholes.

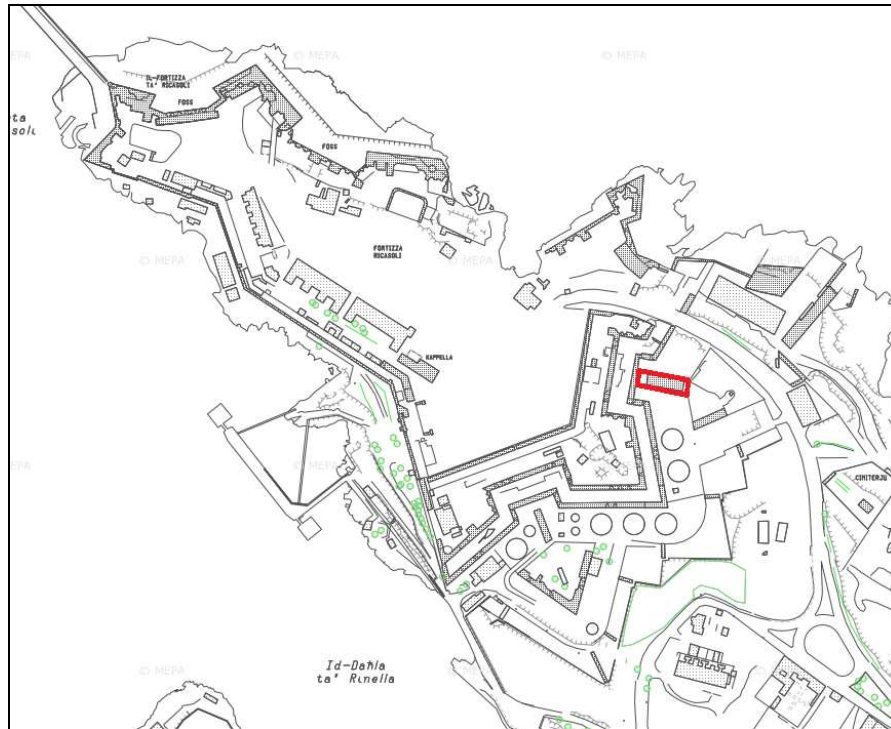
