<b>Property Description</b>	Curtain wall linking No2 to No3 bastions. The work has a largely rock-hewn lower half. The wall is topped with a parapet pierced by eight embrasures, apparently all from the early British period.. Two of the emplacements are enclosed in a box-like enclosure. An expense magazines anchors the right extremity of the curtain where it links with the flank of No. 3 Bastion. A Searchlight emplacement cuts through the rocky scar.

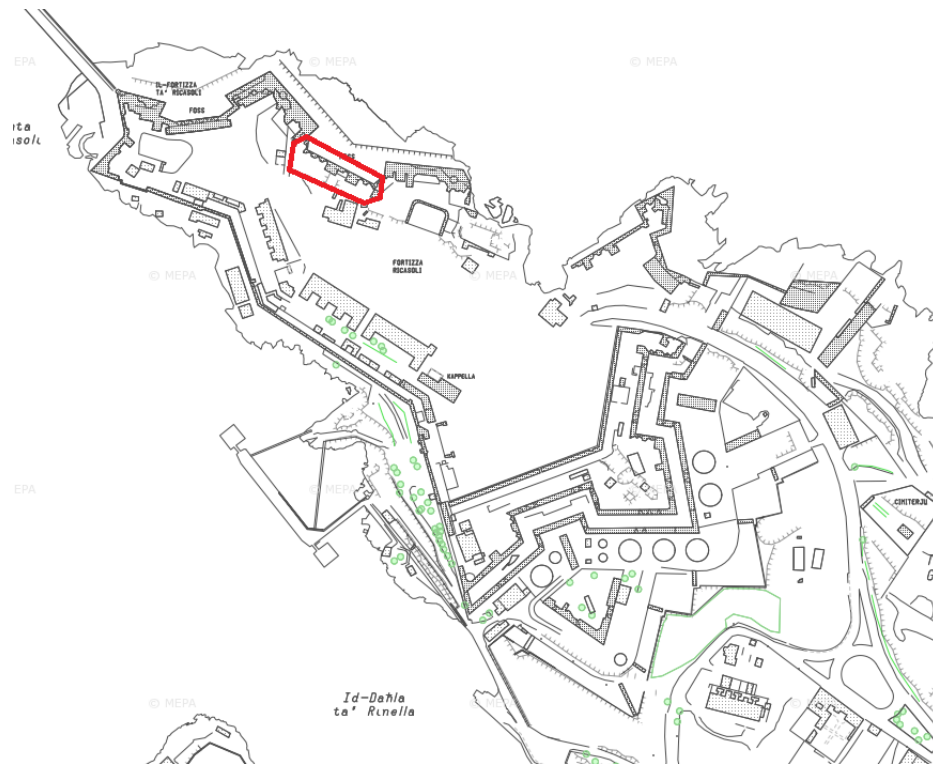
