
Property Description

The ditch of Fort Chambrai is contained along the land front of the fort and has inside it, the two ravelins and counterguard. Some plans of the fort from the late eighteenth century show that the ditch extended towards the western flank of the fortress but the counterscarp and covertway which were erected along this side of the fort have now largely disappeared, leaving only a few traces of walls and dislodged masonry. A caponier is also shown to have protected the sally-port beneath the main bridge serving the main gateway, while a second protected the sally-port on the western flank of the fortress.
