

Outline Description	Pentagonal bastion
Property Description	Notre Dame Bastion is one of the four corner bastions which make up the enceinte of Fort Manoel. It is a pentagonal work with two faces and two flanks. The bastion faces the land front and is commanded by a low cavalier which takes up the larger part of the area inside the bastion. The bastion has only three embrasures in the flank and originally the rest of the parapet was served by a banquette. Contains a small cutting in the parapet at the salient.
