Property Description	A thick masonry wall, built in the shape of a large traverse but intended to act more like a tenaille, runs along nearly all the length of the foot of the curtain inside the main ditch. The wall is set some distance away from the foot of the curtain, shielding it from direct fire.

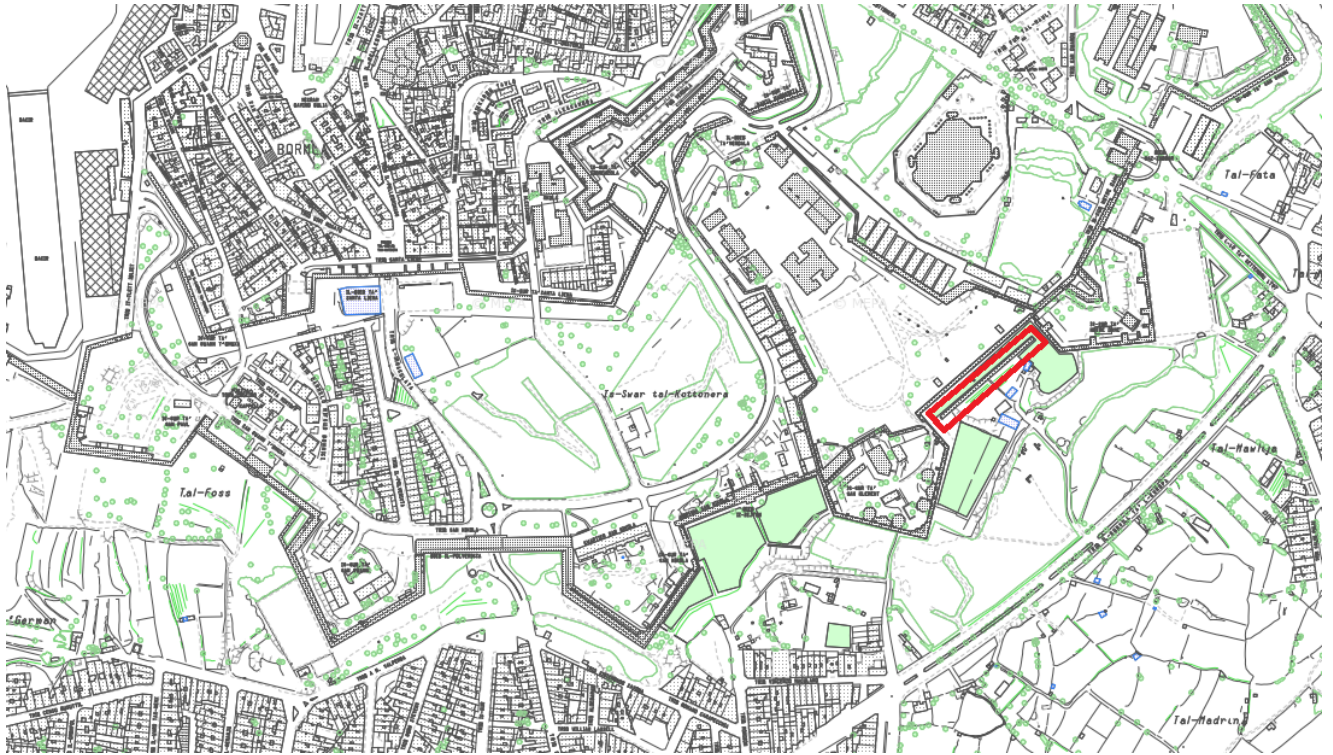
