
Property Description

Notre Dame Curtain links St James Bastion with Notre Dame Bastion. The curtain is a casemated rampart with a continuous walkway interrupted by the gatehouse of Notre Dame Gate halfway along its face. The curtain is backed by a sloping terreplein, filling in the casemates, on the left half. Its interrupted in two places by cuttings made into the rampart to allow for the passage of roads.
