

Nunnally Baby Blanket

This project requires intermediate knitting knowledge (casting on, knit stitch, purl stitch, knitting multiple stitches together, and yarn overs) making it a good project for someone who is looking for a fun and easy lace pattern.

Materials:

Bulky weight yarn

Size 13 knitting needles

Crochet hook or darning needle

Terminology:

yo - yarn over

sl-k2tog-pssso - slip next stitch knitwise, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over.

To Make:

Cast on 98 stitches.

Row 1: (K1, ya, k4, sl-k2tog-pssa, k4, yo) to last stitch, k1

Row 2: Purl

Repeat both rows until desired length

Next row: (k2, p2) across

Repeat for 5 row.

Bind off and weave in ends.
