The extended lees aging and pronounced minerality of Mux rival the power and finesse of Chablis!

An exotic example of a perfect wintery white. Made from an up-and-coming region that has a heavy French viticulture influence.

Gamy & supple; Castelão is the most planted grape in this Moorish influenced landscape in southern Portugal.

CLIFFSNOTES FROM A WINE-SAVVY STAFF

Zinfandel is the first thing that comes to mind when I'm looking for a wine to warm me up on a cold winter's night. Bold, dark fruit, a peppery spiciness, and a little boost in alcohol content are characteristics that are typical in this quintessential Californian varietal. DNA testing has linked Zinfandel to *Primitivo* from Puglia, the heel of Italy, and *Tribidrag* from the Dalmation Coast of Croatia. Genetics aside, Babić, another native Croatian grape, Petite Sirah and Carménère provide robust and hearty alternatives to Zinfandel – a little tinder to start the fire.

11 Inama *Più*, Rosso del Veneto, Italy (Carmenère/Merlot/Raboso Veronese) 54

Hailing from northeastern Italy, in a region famous for producing Prosecco, *Più* is a Carménère blend that is great for Zinfandel lovers looking to expand their palates. With a little spice, a dash of floral on the nose, lively acidity, and powdery tannins, one swirl will make you want to cozy up with someone special in front of a winter fire.

11 Piližota *Black Label*, North Dalmatia, Croatia (Babić) 60

With soft tannins and mouthwatering acidity, the rich, smooth texture of Piližota's Babić will allure lovers of sensuous character. Plucked off the Northern Dalmatian coast of Croatia, the fleshy, blue-skinned grapes translate into a statement of plum, dark berries, and chocolate with teasing pepper and spice for a bodalicious finish. Bold, but inviting, this juicy, full-bodied wine is nothing short of enticing.

Deeper Than Orange and Natural.

Biodynamic viticulture is probably the most fashionable phrase in the world of wines right now. But for the practitioners of biodynamic, this is more than just a trend. The concept of “creating a self-contained, self-sustaining ecosystem responsible for creating and maintaining its individual health and vitality without any external or unnatural additions” runs much deeper. And allowing longer skin contact for the white wines to take on the peculiar orange hue or nominal and sometimes none usage of sulfur is only the tip of the iceberg. It is a belief that connects the biodynamic farmers and winemakers to something much more basic, vital, and at times even spiritual – “a fully integrated farming system that addresses the health of the entire property, and maximizes every aspect of the farm.” What goes into a bottle of wine is only one simple closure in the biodynamic cycle; the whole process outshines the end result.

Scholium Project: If Dr. Jekyll Had Been A Winemaker...

If there were a mathematics of human personalities, the algorithm for Abe Schoener, winemaker of Scholium Project, would be Mad Scientist plus Rock Star, multiplied by the air of a Dandy, and all compounded by a healthy dose of Passion and Humility. Abe’s wines reflect his dedication and belief in the terroir of Californian vineyards that “are distinguished sometimes by being ignored.” The best way to experience the Scholium Project is by total immersion, letting your sense of adventure erase any preconceptions. Afterward, you will think, this is what I would have tasted if Dr. Jekyll had been a winemaker.

13 Naucratis *Lost Slough Vineyards*, Clarksburg 72

Whole-cluster pressed Verdelho from the Sacramento River Delta.

Clean and direct with intense floral components. The most expressive version of this wine yet!

Total production: 176 cases.

13 Rhododactylos *Phillips Farm*, Lodi 80

Whole cluster pressed Cinsault from 140 year-old vines. Light and delicate flavors of raspberries and violet augmented with minerals and spices. A slowly nurtured Blanc de Noirs from the vineyard to the cellar that encompassed a well preserved acidity.

Total production: 265 cases.

The Eyrie Vineyards: Willamette Valley In A Time Capsule.

Within the ever-growing popularity of Oregon wines, The Eyrie Vineyards has stood the test of time.

Founded by David Lett, whom planted Willamette Valley's first Pinot Noir vine in 1965, Eyrie has always been a pioneer in growing the grapes without the use of insecticides, herbicides or systemic fungicides. The results yield wine with a clear voice of the land and of the vintage. In 2005, Jason Lett, David's son, took over his father as the winemaker & vineyard manager, and continues his family's pioneering legacy. David's notes on the weather of each vintage offer a rare glimpse back in time for the following library selections.

86 Pinot Noir *Estate Vineyard*, Willamette Valley 457

May started off warm and dry, giving the vines good growing conditions and inflorescence formation. June weather offered superb bloom conditions. July and August were cooler than normal, but satisfactory, until the last week in August when temperatures rose into the 90's. September displayed almost perfect ripening temperatures and below average rainfall.

96 Pinot Noir *Reserve*, Willamette Valley 523

A warm August was followed by a cool September, allowing even flavor development. Cool days and cold nights began in early October, trapping the flavors in the fruit. Though another rain- affected harvest, fruit was fully ripe. Yields were slightly below normal levels, but not financially threatening as with 1994 and 1998.

85 Pinot Meunier *Estate Vineyard*, Willamette Valley 600

April was our usual beautiful mix of showers and sun. May began to warm and dry up to the last week of the month. June was dry, with perfect bloom conditions, and July was a bit cooler than usual, with temperatures in the mid-70's. August was hot, with no rainfall. September temperatures were lower than normal, and with its entire 1.68 rainfall coming in the last two weeks, caused some picking panic. The first two weeks of October were warm and dry, and perfect for the final maturation of the grapes.

Spreading the Gospel About “Farmer Fizz”: RM Champagnes

Récoltant – Manipulant; what does that mean exactly? The very thought of deciphering Champagne alone can be daunting. But why don’t you see the big name, familiar Champagne names on our wine list? Who are these Champagne producers, with names that you do not recognize? Simply put, they are “grower-producer” Champagnes, where the grapes are grown and then made in to the wine by the same person the grower/winemaker. These great Champagnes in the wine world are what “farm-to-table” food and restaurants are in the United States.

These wines are an expression of the passion of the grower who produces them. As a result, we want to continue to deliver that delicacy by serving them in a way that is uncommon for Champagnes: in bigger wine glasses to show off the aromas and creaminess that make these wines so fantastic.

SAKE | 日本酒

Water: The Soul of Sake

Sake is a simple creation. Four ingredients are used in making sake: rice, water, koji (mold), and yeast. Yet, it is the water that gives soul to the final products — the *terroir* of sake. *Pristine and uncomplicated*. Water is present in every step of the sake production: steaming of the rice, fermentation, and at the end to bring down the alcohol level. The Japanese take water very seriously as 80% of sake is composed by water. Even the slightest impurities in the water will disqualify it from being used for the sake. It is a true artisanal creation at the highest level. Water from the north to the south of Japan is vastly different; just like the *terroir* in Burgundy from Côte de Nuits in the north, down to Beaujolais in the south. The production of sake is an ever-evolving process, even as modern technologies have improved the yield and production process. But it is the water in Japan that makes sake what it truly is: pristine, clean, simple and pure.
