PRELIMINARY COMPETITION FORMAT & DRAW PROCEDURES

ROUND ONE:

- The 12 lowest-ranked PMAs, PMA Rank 35 through to PMA Rank 46 (based on the FIFA/Coca-Cola World Ranking of January 2015), will contest Round One.
- The 12 teams will be paired into six home-and-away series.
- The matches are foreseen to be played in the period 12-17 March 2015.
- The six series winners advance to Round Two.

ROUND TWO:

- The six Round One winners will then join the remaining 34 PMAs in Round Two.
- The 40 teams will be drawn into eight round-robin, home-and-away groups of 5 teams each.
- The matches are foreseen to be played in the period 11 June 2015 to 29 March 2016.
- The eight group winners and four best second placed teams will advance to Round Three.

ROUND THREE:

- The 12 teams qualifying from Round Two will take part in Round Three.
- The 12 teams will be drawn into two round-robin, home-and-away groups of six teams each.
- The matches are foreseen to be played in the period 29 August 2016 to 5 September 2017.
- The third-placed teams of each group advance to Round Four.
- The two group winners and two group runners-up will qualify for the 2018 FIFA World Cup Russia™.

DRAW PROCEDURE:

The draw date, location and procedure for Round Three will be confirmed by the end of Round Two by the Organising Committee for the 2018 FIFA World Cup Russia™.

Round FOUR:

- The two third-placed teams from the two Round Three groups will contest Round Four.
- The teams will play one home-and-away series.
- The matches are foreseen to be played in the period 2-10 October 2017.
- The Round Four winner advances to the intercontinental play-off.

DRAW PROCEDURE:

The draw date, location and procedure for Round Four will be confirmed by the end of Round Three by the Organising Committee for the 2018 FIFA World Cup Russia™.
