## *Betibá*



**Fri May 1 - 2:00 PM / Sun May 3 - 5:00 PM**

When an Argentine industrialist is found dead at his home, the well-known novelist Nurit Iscar covers the story for a national paper. Teaming up with a veteran crime reporter and the new section head, the trio soon realizes this is no random crime.

## *Dust on the Tongue (Tierra en la lengua)*

Despite family patriarch Don Silvio's abusive behavior toward friends and family, his magnetism has allowed him to remain the center of attention his entire life. When his death is imminent, he makes an unusual request—he asks two of his grandchildren to help him die.
