Capitals Development Camp Notes

The Washington Capitals will host their 2015 Prospect Development Camp from July 7-11 at Kettler Capitals Iceplex. All on-ice sessions are free and open to the public.

Capitals development camp is an annual week-long summer session with on- and off-ice workouts designed to help Capitals prospects improve their games and allow the Capitals to evaluate their progress. This is the ninth straight year that the camp is being held at Kettler Capitals Iceplex. Past development camps have been held in Odenton, Md., and Hershey, Pa.

Attendees include Capitals prospects who are under contract and recent Capitals draft picks who have not been signed yet. In addition, several undrafted and free agent amateur players will be in attendance.

The Capitals will host Fan Fest on Saturday, July 11. In addition to the scrimmage, which will be streamed on MonumentalNetwork.com, Fan Fest will feature the team's annual equipment sale, autograph sessions and a special free open skate.

Quick Studies – Two players (Andre Burakovsky and Liam O’Brien) who attended last summer’s development camp played for the Capitals in 2014-15. Burakovsky and O’Brien combined to play in 66 games for Washington last season and registered 24 points (10 goals, 14 assists) and 33 penalty minutes. Ten players who attended the 2014 development camp (Travis Boyd, Andre Burakovsky, Michal Cajkovsky, Pheonix Copley, Christian Djoos, Caleb Herbert, Liam O’Brien, Chandler Stephenson, Jakub Vrana, Nathan Walker) played for Washington’s AHL affiliate, the Hershey Bears, during the 2014-15 season and six players (Michal Cajkovsky, Wade Epp, Garrett Haar, Caleb Herbert, Braden Pimm, Nathan Walker) played for Washington’s ECHL affiliate, the South Carolina Stingrays, in 2014-15.

Age Differential – Turner Ottenbreit (born July 9, 1997), a free agent invite, is the youngest player attending this year’s development camp. Free agent invite Dajon Mingo (born May 7, 1990) is the oldest.






Player Bios

	<p>Keegan Asmundson Goaltender (30) Free Agent</p> <p>Asmundson posted a 13-8-4 record with a 1.96 goals-against average and .930 save percentage in his final season with Canisius College (NCAA) in 2014-15 before winning two of three starts with the South Carolina Stingrays (ECHL). The 6’5”, 234-pound goaltender ranked tied for seventh among Division I goaltenders in save percentage and goals against average. The Inver Groves Heights, Minn., native recorded a shutout in his first career ECHL start, a 4-0 win over Evansville on Mar. 29.</p>
	<p>Riley Barber Right Wing (24) Drafted by WSH in the sixth round, 167th overall, in the 2012 NHL Draft</p> <p>Barber recorded 40 points (20g, 20a) in 38 games with Miami University (NCAA) during the 2014-15 season. The 6’0”, 198-pound right wing finished his junior season ranked first in the National Collegiate Hockey Conference (NCHC) in shots (180), tied for third in goals, and tied for fourth in the Conference in points. Barber registered seven multi-point games and recorded a point in 30 of 38 contests last season. The Pittsburgh native tallied two assists in the NCHC title game, a 3-2 win over St. Cloud State on March 21.</p>
	<p>Marcus Basara Right Wing (95) Free Agent</p> <p>Basara registered 24 points (12g, 12a) in 34 games with the University of Alaska-Fairbanks (NCAA) in 2014-15. The 6’0”, 197-pound forward ranked second among Nanooks skaters in goals and points and tied for fourth in assists as a sophomore.</p>
	<p>Madison Bowey Defenseman (55) Drafted by WSH in the second round, 53rd overall, in the 2013 NHL Draft</p> <p>Bowey earned 60 points (17g, 43a) in 58 games with the Kelowna Rockets (WHL) in 2014-15 and finished the season ranked third among WHL defensemen in goals, fifth in points and tied for fifth in assists. The 6’1”, 202-pound defenseman captained the Kelowna Rockets to the WHL championship last season and led the Rockets to the Memorial Cup final. Bowey was named to the 2015 Memorial Cup All-Star Team and ranked tied for first at the tournament in assists (5) and tied for second in points (6). In addition, Bowey led all defensemen at the Memorial Cup in points and assists. The Winnipeg native also captured a gold medal with Canada at the 2015 IIHF World Junior Championship. Bowey earned four points (1g, 3a) in seven games at the tournament and ranked tied for second among defensemen in points and tied for seventh among all skaters in plus/minus (+8).</p>

The 5'11", 184-pound forward ranked second among Golden Gophers skaters in points and goals and third in assists. He also ranked fourth among all Big Ten skaters in goals and points. Following his senior season, the Hopkins, Minn., native appeared in two games with the Hershey Bears, recording a goal and an assist.</p>
	<p>Lucas Carlsson Defenseman (75) Free Agent</p> <p>Carlsson recorded 14 points (8g, 6a) in nine games with the Brynas under-18 team (Sweden-Jr. U18) and 18 points (6g, 12a) in 42 games with the Brynas junior team (Sweden-Jr.) in 2014-15. The 6'0", 180-pound defenseman also appeared in 16 games the with Brynas senior team (Sweden).</p>

The 6'3", 200-pound goaltender appeared in all but four games for the Bulldogs and finished second among all Division I freshman goaltenders in wins. The Vantaa, Finland, native recorded his first career shutout in a 3-0 win over the University of Minnesota on Nov. 14.

Koules appeared in 69 games during his first season with the Portland Winterhawks (WHL), registering career-highs in goals (27), assists (32) and points (59). The 5'11", 187-pound forward ranked fourth on the team in goals, sixth in assists, and fifth in points.

Lappin registered 21 points (14g, 7a) in 29 games with Brown University (NCAA) in 2014-15. The 6'1", 175-pound forward ranked first on the team in goals and third in points as a junior. The Geneva, Ill., native earned Second Team All-Ivy honors.





Mingo registered 10 points (1g, 9a) and 22 penalty minutes in 39 games with Bowling Green State University (NCAA) in 2014-15 as he made the transition from forward to defenseman. The 5'8", 173-pound defenseman tied for fourth on the team in blocked shots (35) as a redshirt junior.

Murphy tallied 24 points (13g, 11a) in 40 games with Miami University of Ohio (NCAA) in 2014-15. The 5'11", 195-pound forward earned two NCHC offensive player of the week nods during his senior season and finished third on the team in goals.





