

## Gracie \& Her Dragon

This playful little dragon loves to play with his friend Gracie. You'll have fun crocheting these special characters that all ages will enjoy!

## LW3067

Designed by Michele Wilcox.


Gracie measures 71/2" tall, seated. Her dragon measures $151 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long.

RED HEART® Super Saver®: 1 skein each of 312 Black A, 512 Turqua B, 358 Lavender C, 373 Petal Pink D, 324 Bright Yellow E, 706 Perfect Pink F, and 313 Aran G.

Crochet Hook: 3.75 mm [US F-5].
Yarn needle, stitch marker, stuffing, 5" piece of heavy cardboard, two small animals eyes, red crayon (to shade cheeks).

## Special Stitch

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Notes: Gauge is not critical for this project. Work tightly so stuffing will not show between stitches.

## GRACIE

## Head

Beginning at top of head, with $\mathbf{G}$, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook-6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 3: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times-18 sc.
Round 4: [Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 24 sc.
Round 5: [Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times- 30 sc.
Round 6: Sc in each sc around.
Round 7: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times- 36 sc .
Round 8: [Sc in next $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 6 times- 42 sc .
Rounds 9-16: Sc in each sc around.
Round 17: [Sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] 6 times- 36 sts.
Round 18: [Sc in next 4 sc , sc2tog] 6 times- 30 sc.
Round 19: [Sc in next 3 sc , sc2tog] 6 times- 24 sc .
Stuff head.
Round 20: [Sc2tog] 12 times-12 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Finish stuffing head. Thread tail through stitches of last round and pull gently to close opening.

## Hair

With A, ch 2.
Row 1: Work 5 sc in 2 nd ch from hook, turn-5 sc.
Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc across, turn- 10 sc .
Row 3: Ch 1, [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc ] 5 times, turn15 sc.
Row 4: Ch 1, [sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times, turn-20 sc.
Row 5: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Row 6: Ch 1, [sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times, turn-25 sc.
Row 7: Sc in each sc across, turn.
Row 8: Ch 1, [sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 5 times, turn-30 sc.
Rows 9-11: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.
Rows 12-14: Ch 1, sc2tog, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, sc2tog, turn-24 sc at the end of Row 14.
Row 15: Ch 1, [sc2tog] 12 times-12 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew hair in place on head.

## Ponytail (make 2)

Wrap A around 5" piece of heavy cardboard 20 times. Cut strands to make 20 lengths, each 10 " long. Tie a piece of yarn tightly around center of strands. Pull them all together with the tie at top center. Tie another strand around, $1 / 2$ " from first tie. Trim and sew in place.

Facial Features: With F, embroider couched stitch smile. With A, embroider eyes, embroidering one straight stitch for each eye and then embroidering a French knot at the center of each straight stitch. With G, embroider about 4 satin stitches to sculpt a nose.
Tint cheeks by rubbing gently with red crayon.

## Flower

With E, ch 2.
Round 1 (Right Side): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook-6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Sc in each sc around; sl st in next st to join. Fasten off.
Round 3: Join F with sc in back loop of any sc of Round 1, sc in each remaining back loop of Round 1-6 sc.
Round 4: Work 2 sc in each sc around-12 sc.
Round 5: *(Slip st, ch 1, 2 dc) in next in next sc, 2 dc in next st, ch 1 (petal made); repeat from * around, slip st in same st as first slip st-6 petals. Fasten off.
Round 6: With Right Side facing, working in free front loops of Round 2, join D with slip st in any loop, ch 1, 2 sc in same loop, ch 1, *(sl st, ch 1, 2 sc) in next loop, ch 1; repeat from * around. Fasten off.
Sew flower to top of head.

## Body

Beginning at bottom of body with F, ch 2.
Rounds 1-6: Work same as Rounds 1-5 of head-36 sc.
Rounds 7-15: Sc in each sc around.
Round 16: [Sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] 6 times-30 sc.
Round 17: Sc in each sc around.
Round 18: [Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] 6 times-24 sc.
Round 19: Sc in each sc around.
Round 20: [Sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog] 6 times-18 sc. Stuff body.
Round 21: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times-12 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew head to
body.

## Collar

With F, ch 19.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each remaining ch across, turn-18 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew collar around neck.

## Ear (make 2)

With G, ch 2.
Row 1: Work 6 hdc in 2nd ch from hook.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Sew ears in place.

## Arm (make 2)

Beginning at top of arm, with F, ch 2.
Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of head-12 sc.
Rounds 3-12: Sc in each sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Stuff arm. Do not close opening at end of arm.

## Hand (make 2)

With G, ch 2.
Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook-6 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: [Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 3 times- 9 sc.
Rounds 3-5: Sc in each sc around.
Stuff hand lightly. Thread tail through stitches of last round an pull gently to close opening. Push one hand in each arm opening. With F-colored tail of Arm, sew hand in place. Sew Arms to side of Body.

## Foot and leg (make 2)

Beginning at foot, with G, ch 6.
Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 3 ch, 2 sc in last ch-12 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.
Round 2: Work 2 sc in next sc, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 3 sc , sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 2 sc-18 sc.
Rounds 3-5: Sc in each sc around,
Round 6: Sc in next 3 sc, [sc2tog] 6 times, sc in last 3 sc-12 sc.
Rounds 7-12: Sc in each Sc around.
Fasten off. Stuff leg.

## Pant leg (make 2)

Beginning at top of leg with F, ch 2.
Rounds 1-3: Work same as Rounds 1-3 of head-18 sc.
Round 4: Working in back loops only, sc in each sc

## around.

Rounds 5-9: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off. Insert one leg in pant leg. With $\mathbf{D}$, sew in place behind Round 4 . Sew the front loops of Round 4 to body in
sitting position.

## DRAGON

## Head

Beginning at tip of mouth with B, ch 2 .
Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of Gracie's head-12 sc.
Round 3: Sc in each sc around.
Round 4: [Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times- 15 sc .
Round 5: Sc in each sc around.
Round 6: [Sc in next $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next sc] 3 times-18 sc.
Round 7: Sc in each sc around.
Round 8: Sc in next 3 sc , [sc2tog] 6 times, sc in last 3 sc-12 sc.
Rounds 9 and 10: Sc in each sc around.
Round 11: Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 6 sc , sc in last $3 \mathrm{sc}-18 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 12: Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 6 sc , sc in last $6 \mathrm{sc}-24 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 13 and 14: Sc in each sc around.
Round 15: [Sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{sc} 2 \mathrm{tog}] 6$ times- 18 sc .
Following package directions, attach small animal eyes on top of head between Rounds 13 and 14.
Round 16: [Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times-12 sc.
Stuff head.
Round 17: [Sc2tog] 6 times-6 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through stitches of last round and pull gently to close opening.

Facial Features: With A, embroider French knot nostrils and straight stitch smile.

## Neck and Body

With B, ch 12; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.
Round 1: Sc in each ch around-12 sc. Do not join, work in continuous rounds (spirals). Place a marker for beginning of round. Move marker up as each round is completed.
Rounds 2-10: Sc in each sc around.
Round 11: Sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 6 sc , sc in last $3 \mathrm{sc}-18 \mathrm{sc}$.
Round 12: Sc in each sc around.
Round 13: Sc in next $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in each of next 6 sc , sc in last $6 \mathrm{sc}-24 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 14-22: Sc in each sc around.
Round 23: [Sc in next 2 sc , sc2tog] 6 times- 18 sc .
Rounds 24 and 25: Sc in each sc around.
Round 26: [ Sc in next sc, sc2tog] 6 times- 12 sc .
Begin stuffing body. Continue to stuff and work progresses.
Rounds 27-29: Sc in each sc around.
Round 30: Sc2tog, sc in each remaining sc across-11 sc.
Round 31: Sc in each sc around.
Round 32: Repeat Round 30-10 sc.

Rounds 33 and 34: Repeat last 2 rounds- 9 sc.
Rounds 35-38: Sc in each sc around.
Round 39: Repeat Round 30-8 sc.
Rounds 40-44: Sc in each sc around.
Round 45: Repeat Round 30-7 sc.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through stitches of last round and pull gently to close opening.

## Ear (make 2)

With B, ch 5 , sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in last ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew one ear to each side of head, above the eyes.

## Spine

With E, [ch 4, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in next ch] 16 times. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew spine in place across length of back.

## Leg (make 4)

With B, ch 2.
Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of Gracie's head-12 sc.
Rounds 3 and 4: Sc in each sc around.
Round 5: [Sc2tog] 3 times, sc in last $6 \mathrm{sc}-9 \mathrm{sc}$.
Rounds 6 and 7: Sc in each sc around.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Stuff leg and sew in place.

## Wing (make 2)

With C, ch 8.
Note: Work in back loops only throughout wing.
Row 1: Sc in 2 nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch , hdc in next 2 ch , dc in last 2 ch , turn- 7 sts.
Row 2: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), dc in first 2 dc , hdc in next 2 hdc, sc in last 3 sc , turn
Row 3: Ch 1 , sc in first 3 sc , hdc in next 2 hdc, dc in last 2 dc, turn.
Row 4: Repeat Row 2.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Sew wings to body, one on each side of spine.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
RED HEART® Super Saver®, Art. E300 available in solid color 7 oz ( 198 g ), 364 yd ( 333 m ); multicolor, heather and print 5 oz (141 g ), $244 \mathrm{yd}(223 \mathrm{~m})$, flecks $5 \mathrm{oz}(141 \mathrm{~g}), 260 \mathrm{yds}$ $(238 \mathrm{~m})$ skeins.

[^0]:    GAUGE: 16 sts $=4^{\prime \prime} ; 16$ rnds $=4^{\prime \prime}$ in single crochet. CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.
