Dear Chief Judge Robinson:

Pursuant to the Court's April 6, 2004 Order requesting a quarterly report on the status of various related litigation matters, Red Hat, Inc. ("Red Hat") submits this letter as an update to its previous letter, dated March 22, 2007. Although Red Hat is not a party to these other related cases, Red Hat offers the following summary based upon publicly available information.

1. *SCO Group, Inc. v. International Business Machines Corp. ("IBM")*

As reported in our previous letter, in a March 2, 2007 Order, the Court denied SCO's Motion for Relief for IBM's Spoliation of Evidence. On March 16, 2007, SCO filed a Motion for Reconsideration of the Order.

The Court has taken this motion under advisement.

2. *SCO Group, Inc. v. AutoZone, Inc.*

Since the filing of our last letter to the Court, no significant activity has occurred in this case.

3. *SCO v. Novell, Inc.*

On April 3, 2007, the Court extended the deadline to complete all outstanding fact discovery to April 30, 2007. On April 10, 2007, the Court extended the deadline to file dispositive motions to April 20, 2007.

On April 9, 2007, SCO filed a Motion for Partial Summary Judgment on its First, Second, and Fifth Causes of Action, and for Summary Judgment on Novell's First Counterclaim.

On April 20, 2007, the Court granted the parties' stipulated motion for a protective order to provide for the production of certain confidential information by third-party CA, Inc.

On April 20, 2007, Novell filed motions for summary judgment on SCO's First and Third Claims and motions for partial summary judgment on SCO's Second and Fifth Claims. The Court heard arguments on these motions on May 31, 2007 and June 4, 2007, and has taken these motions under advisement.
