ROBERT GREENHALGH ALBION, of the Class of 1918; Master of Arts and Doctor of Philosophy of Harvard; Professor of History of Princeton University; who beginning his career as a brilliant undergraduate editor-in-chief of the *Orient* has developed into one of the most eminent of American naval historians and so recognized at home and abroad; able administrator; for several years directing the summer sessions at Princeton; brought up in Portland, the beautiful town that is seated by the sea, he has written interesting books on the Merchant Marine also; representing today his class on its thirtieth reunion and gladly honored as one of the many scholars and teachers who have in the academic world bound with friendly ties Princeton and Bowdoin.
