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Introduction

In this study you will find in the first part some statistics of the FINA Swimming World Championships (50m) held since 1973 and the podiums and number of medals obtained by National Federation.

In the second part appear the standings of the first three places at all events of these Championships followed by several classifications which are listed either by the number of titles or medals by swimmer or National Federation.

It should be made clear that these standings only have a historical aim and not any sportive signification because the comparison between the achievements of swimmers of different generations is always unfair for several reasons:

1. The period of time - The World Championships (50m) were organised irregularly (1973, 1975, 1978, 1982, 1986, 1991, 1994, 1998, 2001, 2003, 2005, 2007).
2. The evolution of the program - The number of events has not stopped growing.

To unify the statistics of FINA World Chamionships 1973-2007, only finalists of relays are mentionned and not those who swam only in qualifications.

This edition may manifest certain errors; we hope that this will be remedied for the next edition with the assistance of our readers.

LIST OF ABBREVIATIONS - The abbreviations used for each National Federation are included at the end of this volume. However, for Germany, for the period of 1973-1991, the abbreviations FRG for the Federal Republic and GDR for the Democratic Republic have been used. Russia, Belarus, Ukraine were part of USSR until 1991.

Vous trouverez dans la première partie de cette étude des statistiques sur les Championnats du Monde de Natation (50 m.) organisés depuis 1973 ainsi que les podiums et nombres de médailles obtenues par chaque Fédération Nationale.

Dans la seconde partie figurent les classements des trois premiers de toutes les épreuves de ces Championnats puis plusieurs classifications par nombre de titres ou de médailles par nageur ou nageuse ou par fédération nationale.

Attention, ces classements n'ont qu'un intérêt historique mais n'ont pas de signification sportive car les comparaisons entre les palmarès des nageurs sont toujours injustes en fonction de divers critères :

1. Les époques - Les Championnats du Monde (50 m.) ne furent disputés qu'irrégulièrement (1973, 1975, 1978, 1982, 1986, 1991, 1994, 1998, 2001, 2003, 2005, 2007).
2. L'évolution du programme - Le nombre d'épreuves n'a cessé d'augmenter

Afin d'unifier les statistiques des Championnats du Monde FINA 1973-2007, seuls les finalistes des relais sont mentionnés; les nageurs n'ayant disputé que les qualifications ne le sont pas.

Cette édition peut comporter quelques erreurs; nous espérons avec l'aide de nos lecteurs y remédier dans l'édition suivante.

LISTE DES ABREVIATIONS - La liste utilisée pour chaque Fédération Nationale figure à la fin de fascicule. Cependant pour l'Allemagne, pour la période 1973-1991, les abréviations FRG pour la République Fédérale d'Allemagne et GDR pour la République Démocratique ont été utilisées. La Russie, la Biélorussie, l'Ukraine faisaient partie de l'URSS jusqu'en 1991.
