# REPORT OF THE CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER

This booklet is published pursuant to the Election Act, R.S.N., 1970, as amended at s.s. 168(1)

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#### **PREFACE**

The resignations of Thomas V. Hickey and William W. Marshall from the House of Assembly on November 17, 1986 resulted in vacancies in the Districts of St. John's East and St. John's East Extern.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council was moved to issue a Proclamation providing for the holding of elections immediately and writs were issued on Monday, the 17th day of November, 1986 ordering the day of polling be Tuesday, December 9, 1986 in both St. John's East and St. John's East Extern.

These Writs ordered Nominations conclude on Saturday, November 29, 1986. Three candidates were nominated in each District with each of the political parties active in this Province represented, viz. Liberals, New Democrats, and Progressive Conservatives.

Gene Long of the New Democrats was elected in St. John's East and Kevin Parsons of the Progressive Conservatives in St. John's East Extern. Both were sworn in as members of the House of Assembly for these Districts at Government House on December 29, 1986.

The Notices of Grant of Poll are included to assist interested persons with future activities.

During these By-Elections, for the first time, Special Polling Stations were set up in acute care treatment centers and correctional facilities. These procedures were effective and efficient and gave rise to little public comment. Regular Polls were conducted in centers and facilities located in the District of St. John's East, viz. The Leonard A. Miller Center, St. John's City Lock-Up, and Her Majesty's Penitentiary for eligible electors resident in St. John's East. These electors did not require Special Poll arrangements.
