

JANUARY 9-11

It was windy and there was intermittent rain the day before the tournament started, but conditions were near ideal for the three days of play. Early fog burned off and sunshine made ideal conditions Friday. The weather was clear and warm on Saturday, and Sunday was bright, although it was cool.

Format of play was changed with the field increased to 100 professionals, half playing Cypress Point and half Monterey Peninsula the first day, and switching courses on Saturday. The field was cut to the low 60 pros for the final round Sunday at Pebble Beach. Sam Snead and Ben Hogan both were forced to withdraw two days before the tournament because of scheduling conflicts.

Lloyd Mangrum registered his second victory on the Monterey Peninsula, clipping a stroke off his own tournament record with a winning total of 204. Dr. Cary Middlecoff and Ed Crowley won the Pro-Am with a score of 190.
