| Headcount | A count of unique individuals. |
| Home Language | The home language identifies what primary language is normally spoken in the home. If more than one <br> language is normally spoken in the home, only the language that is spoken most often is reported. This <br> information is taken from Form 1701. |
| Homeschooled (Children) | Children may be taught at home without the supervision of a certified teacher, but are required to be <br> registered with a public, francophone, distributed learning, or independent school. |
| Msk | Abbreviation for Mask. When reporting data, the number or percentage must be suppressed (or <br> "masked") if they are elements of a population that is one through nine. For example, 8 students in a <br> school write the Japanese 12 exam. The results for these students are masked. However, if 15 <br> students write the exam in the school, with 8 achieving a letter grade of C, the results are not masked <br> (as the total population is greater than nine). |
