
Property Function

The entrance to the palazzo consists of a neo-classical gate with a set of Ionic columns. The palazzo consists of two floors with a symmetrical façade; the first floor is characterized by a portico with a series of Ionic columns which sustain the veranda, found on the second floor, which runs all around the building. The second floor has a series of windows which are typical of this period, where the trims are embellished with floral moulds. The interior has been extensively altered in recent times while the palazzo was being used as a nightclub. The Palazzo used to be surrounded by a large garden, of which most of its area was developed.
