

REGULATIONS

OF THE 2014 SENIOR EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP IN FREESTYLE, GRECO-ROMAN AND FEMALE WRESTLING

1 - 6.4.2014 VANTAA, FINLAND

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The International Federation of Associated Wrestling Styles (FILA) has entrusted the Finnish Wrestling Federation with organizing the 2014 Senior European Championships in Freestyle, Greco-Roman and Female Wrestling.
2. The competition will be held according to the FILA Rules of Wrestling and all other Regulations of FILA.
3. The 2014 Senior European Championships in Freestyle, Greco-Roman and Female Wrestling will be prepared by the Organizing Committee set up within the Finnish Wrestling Federation and wrestling club Ylä-Tikkurilan Kipinä.
4. The Finnish Wrestling Federation is responsible for sending the entry forms which are needed for obtaining visas at the latest two months before the Championship to all the National Federations.

Federations who are required for visas to take part in the Championship must contact the Finnish embassy or consulate (or the embassy or consulate of the EU-country which represents Finland in the country concerned) in their country of residence. Finnish Wrestling Federation will prepare the Visa Support letter to the Federations if needed.

3. PARTICIPATION

1. Participation at the 2014 Senior European Championships in Freestyle, Greco-Roman and Female Wrestling is open to all national wrestling federations affiliated with FILA, provided that they have fulfilled their financial and information obligations toward FILA according to

the FILA Statutes and Regulations and towards the Organizing Committee as per these Regulations for the duration of the Championships.

2. Each national Federation can enter a maximum of one (1) wrestler per category in all three styles.
3. Wrestlers in the junior age category are allowed to participate in the competitions for seniors. However, wrestlers aged 18 in the year concerned must provide a medical certificate and parental authorisation. Wrestlers aged 17 in the year in question may not participate in senior competitions. Wrestlers are under the entire responsibility of their National Federations.
4. Each wrestler must have a valid FILA licence purchased beforehand from FILA.
5. The structure of the official delegation per style laid down by FILA is as follows:

Referees are included among the official persons. The number of official persons will be established after the preliminary entries creating the base of payment of accreditation fees.

6. Entries on the official entry forms are to be sent by e-mail or fax as follows both to the FILA and the Organising Committee:
 - **Preliminary entries till February 1, 2014**
 - **Nominative entries till March 1, 2014**
 - **Final entries** are to be made **six (6) hours** before weigh-in to the competition secretariat provided that preliminary and nominative entries were duly submitted. Failing to do so wrestlers are not authorized to take part in the Championships.

For accreditation purposes a photo must also be attached to the nominative entries.

7. The above conditions must be respected by National Federations wishing to attend the Championships in order to book the accommodation according to the Regulations.
8. Only Category Olympic referees may officiate in the competition. Referees must present their valid licence stamp for the year 2014. Referees are obliged to wear the official FILA uniform.

4. TECHNICAL CONDITIONS

1. The competition will be held according to the FILA Rules of Wrestling.
2. The competitions will be conducted in the following weight categories:
No weight tolerance is allowed.

Freestyle wrestling:	57, 61, 65, 70, 74, 86, 97 and 125 kg
Female wrestling:	48, 53, 55, 58, 60, 63, 69 and 75 kg
Greco-roman wrestling:	59, 66, 71, 75, 80, 85, 98 and 130 kg
3. 3 (three) FILA approved mats will be used for the competitions.
4. Each wrestler has to pass a medical examination in his own country at least three days before leaving his country for the Championship in Finland. The results of this examination should be recorded in the wrestler's licence book.
5. Each wrestler must undergo a medical examination one (1) hour before weigh-in.
6. At weigh-in all female wrestlers have to produce a certificate of their gender. This certificate kept inside the woman wrestler's licence book must be signed by the doctor of the National Federation and has a permanent validity.
If a woman wrestler does not present this certificate she will be disqualified from the competition.
7. The Organizing Committee assures the first aid during the competition. The annual licence issued by FILA covers the hospital costs for the participating wrestler in case of accident. If an insured person wishes to undergo a medical examination or treatment which is not the consequence of an accident during the Championships, the cost of such examination or treatment must be borne by the person concerned or by his/her National Federation. The reimbursement of these expenses can under no circumstances be claimed from the insurance company.
8. The sampling procedure and the doping control will be conducted according to IOC, WADA and FILA Regulations. The samples will be analyzed in the following IOC accredited laboratory: United Medix Laboratories, Espoo, Finland.

5. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

1. The organizing committee will give individual prizes for each weight category as follows:

1st place	gold medal, certificate
2nd place	silver medal, certificate
3rd places	bronze medals, certificates
2. Each participant shall receive diploma.

3. The first three teams in each style receive a special cup.
4. The points obtained after placings in the individual competition will determine the team classification. The wrestlers placed 1st-10th will receive 10-1 points. If there is a tie for the final classification, the gold, the silver and bronze medals will be taken into consideration in order to determine the team winner.

6. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

1. Each participating team must be present at the opening ceremony of the Championship according to the organizing committee's instructions.
2. The national flags of the countries whose wrestlers and teams obtained 1st - 3rd places will be hoisted once the medals and cups have been awarded.
3. The national anthem will be played for each individual and team champion.
4. The organizers must provide the flags and national anthems, however, the teams are requested to bring their national flag (100 x 150 cm) and anthem on CD which are to be handed over to organizers at accreditation. Should these items be available for the Organizing Committee in advance it is the team leaders' duty to check them.

7. TRANSPORTATION

1. Free transportation will be available from Helsinki Airport, Helsinki Railway Station, Tikkurila Railway Station and Helsinki harbours to the accreditation.

Delegations must send the schedule and flight details of team members to the organizer.

8. ACCOMODATION

3. Accommodation for all the competitors is provided in twin rooms with full sanitation provisions. According to international standards no single rooms shall be provided for national delegations. Due to limited availability any further single room requirements must be made in advance and shall incur additional payments.
4. All delegations have to check-out of the hotel room latest until 12 am on the day of departure.
5. Lunches and dinners are served in the Trio Sport Center in the competition area. Breakfasts are served in the hotels concerned.
6. Meals corresponding to a calorific value of the FILA Rules (5.000 cal/day) will be served in Trio Sport Center in the competition area.
7. Sauna is available for all teams in Hotel Rantasipi Airport. The gym is available for all teams in Hotel Cumulus Airport.
Sauna is also available in the training venue.
8. The Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility neither for people who are not on the list of entries by name nor for those entered over and above the number allowed by the FILA Regulations unless this is agreed beforehand.

9. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

1. The delegation's leader shall settle his team's participation and engagement fees to the FILA authorized Organizing Committee and FILA Delegate upon arrival before accreditation for each wrestler per style in one payment. To speed up the accreditation procedure, each nation is recommended to send digital photos of all participants to the Organizing Committee (along with the final entry) for accreditation cards use.

2. No accreditation shall take place without the participation and engagement fees being paid.
3. All participants and accompanying persons are required to pay the authorized Organizing Committee CHF 180,-/day/person including accommodation, meals and local transportation + competition: entry to the hall of competition and possible other activities, arranged by the organizer. The applicable period is the official duration of the Championships plus 2 (two) days before and 1 (one) day after it.

The minimum length of accreditation is 4 (four) nights.

An engagement fee of CHF 100.-/wrestler or equivalent in EUR or USD is also to be paid to the FILA Delegate.

4. Extra single rooms are not allocated to the delegations. **CHF 250** (or the equivalent in EUR and USD) **must be paid** (instead of CHF 180) **for each single room for each night.**
5. **To speed up the accreditation procedure, each Federation is recommended to pay all costs in advance, transferring the amount to the organizers account:**

Money transfers should be made until 26 March 2014.
6. If a National Federation does not follow the deadline procedure, a CHF 5000 fine per team will be perceived to compensate for the fees undertaken by the FILA and the organiser and its participation in the competition will be refused.
7. **Delegations with more members than allowed in article 3.5 as well as delegations (persons) staying more than eight (8) days must pay 200 CHF / day / person.**
8. FILA and CELA Commission members who are called to meet during the Championships will be accredited under the same conditions as the teams present.
9. Delegation leaders will be responsible for any damage incurred by members of their delegation during their stay.

10. JOURNALISTS - VIDEO RECORDINGS - INTERNET

2. Journalists are responsible for their own accommodation and board. However, hotels can be suggested by the Organizing Committee.
3. A Press centre comprising necessary equipment will be made available to journalists in the competition venue the day before and one day after the Championships.

4. Nations wishing to make video camera recording of the Championships must apply for FILA approval one month before the event. A specific invoice will be issued to each country concerned.
5. Video recordings for educational purposes can be approved upon preliminary agreement with FILA and organizers. No camera can be used without the conditions above.
6. Possession of broadcasting rights for non-EBU member television companies is possible through stipulation of contract with FILA and payment of fees specified by FILA Financial Rules.
