AGED PAIR KILLED BY ILLINOIS BOMBS

Blast in Springfield Cabaret Wrecks Their Home.

SPRINGFIELD, Ill., Jan. 26 (A. P.)—Two persons were killed early today by time bombs placed in a dance restaurant within sight of the State Capitol buildings.

Both were asleep when the bomb exploded at 4:30 o'clock, blowing out the first floor of the building and setting fire to the second. Other occupants of the building escaped with slight injuries.

WOMAN A SUICIDE UNDER I. R. T. TRAIN

Plunges From Platform in Path of Cars.

Traffic on the West Side I. R. T. express tracks was temporarily tied up today when a woman, later identified as Madeline McCannon, 49 years old, of 130 Christopher street, plunged from an uptown platform at Fourteenth street into the path of an approaching train.

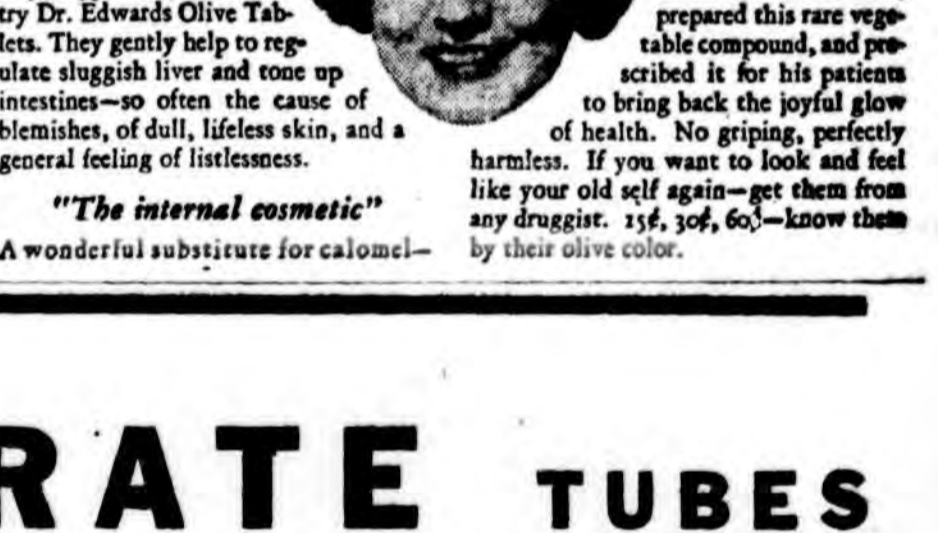

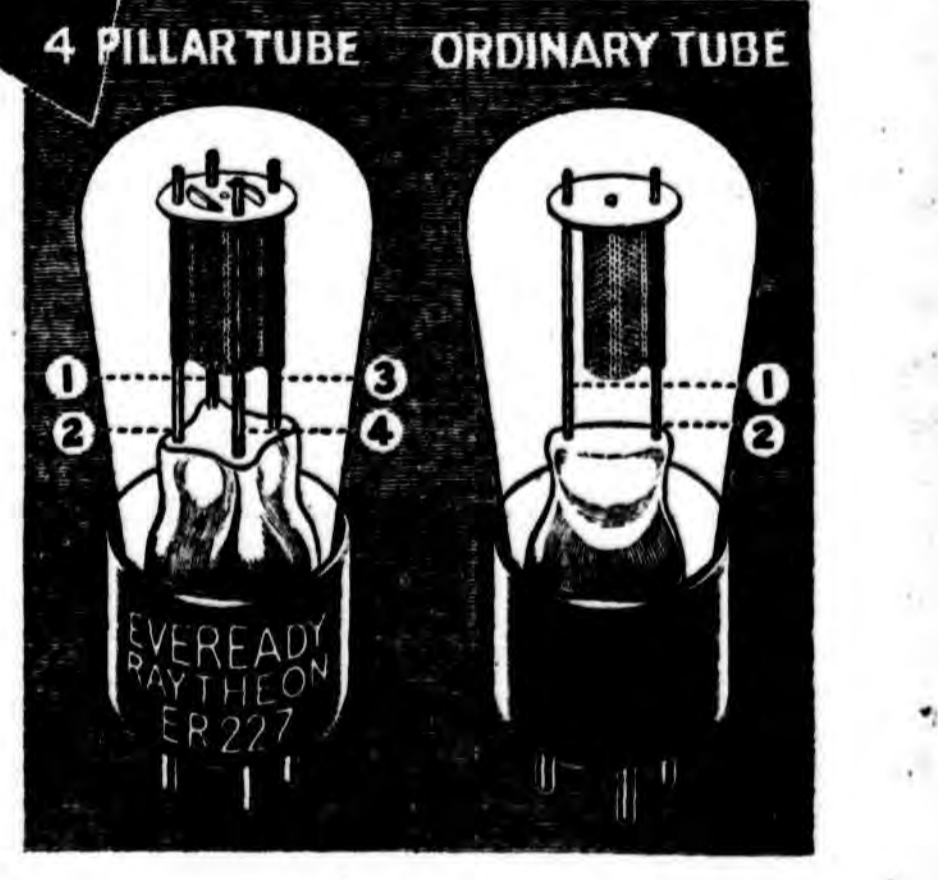
