

The Australia Day 1988 Honours List includes the award of AC to Justices of the High Court.

The Bicentenary year has been seen by the Council for the Order of Australia - the independent advisory body which has the responsibility for recommending awards in the General Division of the Order - as the appropriate time to establish the practice of affording recognition to the members of the Court within the Australian honours system.

The Council does not, however, make awards merely on the basis of office, and the awards to members of the High Court do not breach this principle, but are a continuation of the Order of Australia's tradition of recognising merit. The Council has concluded that appointment to the High Court of Australia is itself evidence of merit and excellence within the legal profession and in service to the law.
