## METHODOLOGY:

The sample size for the survey is 600 active voters taken from a listed sample of voters who have voted in the 2010 or 2012 general elections, or registered since the 2012 general election. The margin of error is +/- $4 \%$. The MoE for the GOP Primary question is +/- $8.4 \%$ and for the DEM Primary Question is +/- 6.8\%. 480 interviews were completed using automated telephone technology and 120 were conducted using mobile based survey technology. All interviews were conducted April 22-24, 2014 by Vox Populi Polling. The total percentages for responses may not equal $100 \%$ due to rounding.
