ALTERATION OF BOUNDARIES – THE VILLAGE OF BETHUNE AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN NO. 190

- 1 Pursuant to sections 13, 14, and 24 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*, the Council of the Village of Bethune has submitted an application to alter its boundaries to the Minister of Government Relations in the form prescribed by the Minister together with:
 - (a) a map showing the proposed alteration of boundaries which involves withdrawing territory from the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 and adding it to the Village of Bethune:
 - (b) a certified copy of a resolution of the Council of the Village of Bethune requesting the proposed alteration; and
 - (c) a certified copy of a complementary resolution of the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 affected by the proposed alteration.
- 2 Therefore, as it is considered desirable to alter the boundaries of the Village of Bethune, the undersigned hereby orders, pursuant to sections 13, 14, and 24 of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984* that:
 - (a) the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin No. 190 and the Village of Bethune be altered by withdrawing from the rural municipality and adding to the village the territory described in Schedule A;
 - (b) Schedule B is conclusively deemed to be the legal description of the boundary of the Village of Bethune; and
 - $\mbox{ (c)} \quad \mbox{the alteration shall take effect on and from the date of this Order.}$

- (1) the most southerly 50.076 metres of the north half of legal subdivision 14, EXCEPTING the most easterly 120.548 metres:
- (2) the most easterly 50.0 metres of the south half of legal subdivision 13; and
- (3) the most southerly 50.076 metres of the most easterly 50.0 metres of the north half of legal subdivision 13.

Schedule B

The boundaries of the Village of Bethune shall comprise the territory in the Province of Saskatchewan lying within Section 24, Township 20, Range 24, West of the Second Meridian, described as:

THE SASKATCHEWAN COLLEGE OF PSYCHOLOGISTS – THE COLLEGE OF PSYCHOLOGY PROFESSIONAL CORPORATION BYLAWS

Title

1 These bylaws may be cited as The College of Psychology Professional Corporation Bylaws.

Definitions

2 In these bylaws:

"college" means the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists;

"member" means a member of the college:

"professional corporation" means a professional corporation within the meaning of *The Professional Corporations Act*;

"registrar" means the registrar of the college.

Approval for incorporation

- 3(1) A member who intends to incorporate a professional corporation for the provision in Saskatchewan of professional services to which *The Psychologists Act, 1997* relates shall first forward to the registrar the proposed articles of incorporation.
- (2) The registrar may provide his or her consent to an incorporation of a professional corporation if he or she is satisfied that:
 - (a) the proposed name of the corporation is not so similar to names of other professional corporations as to be misleading or confusing; and
 - (b) the professional corporation will meet the requirements of $\it The\ Professional\ Corporations\ Act.$

Proposed changes in corporate structure

- 4(1) A professional corporation shall notify the registrar in writing of any proposed change of name or of any proposed changes to its corporate structure, ownership or directors.
- (2) The registrar may provide his or her consent to a change in the name, corporate structure, ownership or directors of a professional corporation if he or she is satisfied that:
 - (a) the proposed name of the corporation is not so similar to names of other professional corporations as to be misleading or confusing; and
 - (b) the professional corporation will meet the requirements of *The Professional Corporations Act*.

Application for permit

- 5(1)A member may apply to the college on behalf of a professional corporation for a permit pursuant to section 8 of *The Professional Corporations Act* by providing to the registrar the information required by that section together with an application fee of \$150.00
- (2) A member may apply to the college on behalf of a professional corporation for a renewal of a permit pursuant to subsection 8(5) of *The Professional Corporations Act* by providing to the registrar the information required by that subsection together with a renewal fee of \$100.

Coming into force

6 In accordance with subsection 19(2) of *The Professional Corporations Act*, these bylaws come into force, in accordance with section 14 of *The Psychologists Act*, 1997 when they are approved by the Minister responsible for *The Psychologists Act*, 1997 and published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette*.

THE COLLEGE OF PSYCHOLOGY LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIPS BYLAWS

Title

1 These bylaws may be cited as The College of Psychology Limited Liability Partnerships Bylaws.

Definitions

2 In these bylaws:

"college" means the Saskatchewan College of Psychologists;

"limited liability partnership" or "LLP" means a limited liability partnership provided for under Part IV of *The Partnership Act*;

"member" means a member of the college;

"registrar" means the registrar of the college.

Limited Liability Partnerships (LLP)

- **3**(1) A partnership of members that intends to apply to the Corporations Branch to be registered as an LLP shall forward to the registrar a copy of the proposed application, together with a fee of \$150.00 for the provision of the statement required by clause 86(4)(f) of *The Partnership Act*, and any other information necessary to process the application.
- (2) The registrar shall, upon receiving the material mentioned in subsection (1), review the status of each partner listed in the application and provide the partnership with a certificate certifying that each proposed partner in the LLP is or is not a member of the college and shall include any conditions or limitations on his or her practice.
- (3) Upon registration, an LLP shall immediately give notice to all its existing clients advising of its registration and explaining in general terms the potential changes in liability to the partners.

Proposed changes in partners

- 4(1) A professional corporation shall notify the registrar in writing of any proposed change in the partnership.
- (2) The registrar shall, upon receiving a notice of a proposed change under subsection (1), review the status of each partner listed in the application and provide the partnership with a certificate certifying that each proposed partner in the LLP is or is not a member of the college and shall include any conditions or limitations on his or her practice.

Register of LLPs

5 The registrar shall keep a register of all LLP's in which members are partners, including the names and addresses of all partners, and any limitations on the practice of the LLP.

Coming into force

6 In accordance with section 14 of *The Psychologists Act, 1997*, these bylaws come into force, when they are approved by the Minister responsible for *The Psychologists Act, 1997* and published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette*.

A PROCLAMATION

W HEREAS the Province of Saskatchewan was, by Royal Warrant, dated the Twenty-fifth day of August, 1906, granted and assigned The Armorial Ensigns following, that is to say Vert three Garbs in fesse Or, on a Chief of the last a Lion passant guardant Gules; and

Whereas the Province of Saskatchewan adopted the flower known botanically as *lilium philadelphicum andinum* and popularly called the "prairie lily" as the floral emblem of the province by virtue of the *Floral Emblem Act*, being chapter 404 of the Revised Statutes of Saskatchewan, 1965; and

Whereas a committee of the Assembly was established by resolution of the Assembly dated February 28, 1968, and reestablished by Order in Council 996/68 dated May 31, 2968, "to consider the matter of selecting a design for a distinctive flag for the Province of Saskatchewan"; and

Whereas the said committee recommended to the Government of Saskatchewan under date of March 26, 1969, the adoption of a Provincial Flag based upon a design selected from amongst four thousand and twenty-five submissions invited by the Committee: and

Whereas it is expedient to adopt a flag of historical and regional significance as the Provincial Flag of the Province of Saskatchewan; and

Whereas is is desirable that such flag have a background screen of green and gold symbolic of the northern forested areas of the province and of the southern grain field areas, and that the flag should bear the shield of the Armorial Bearings of the Province granted by Royal Warrant in 1906 and carry in the fly the provincial floral emblem.

Now Know YE, that by and with the advice of Our Executive Council of Our Province, We do by these Presents proclaim that the flag described and illustrated in the schedule hereto attached is hereby adopted as the Provincial Flag of the Province as and from the twenty-second day of September, 1969, to be flown and used on the express permission of His Honour the Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Saskatchewan on the advice of the Provincial Secretary.

OF ALL OF WHICH PRESENTS Our Loving Subjects of Our said Province and all others whom they may concern are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

In Testimony Whereof we have caused the Great Seal of our Province to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS: Our right trusty and well beloved the Honourable Robert Leith Hanbidge, Q.C., Lieutenant Governor of Our Province of Saskatchewan.
