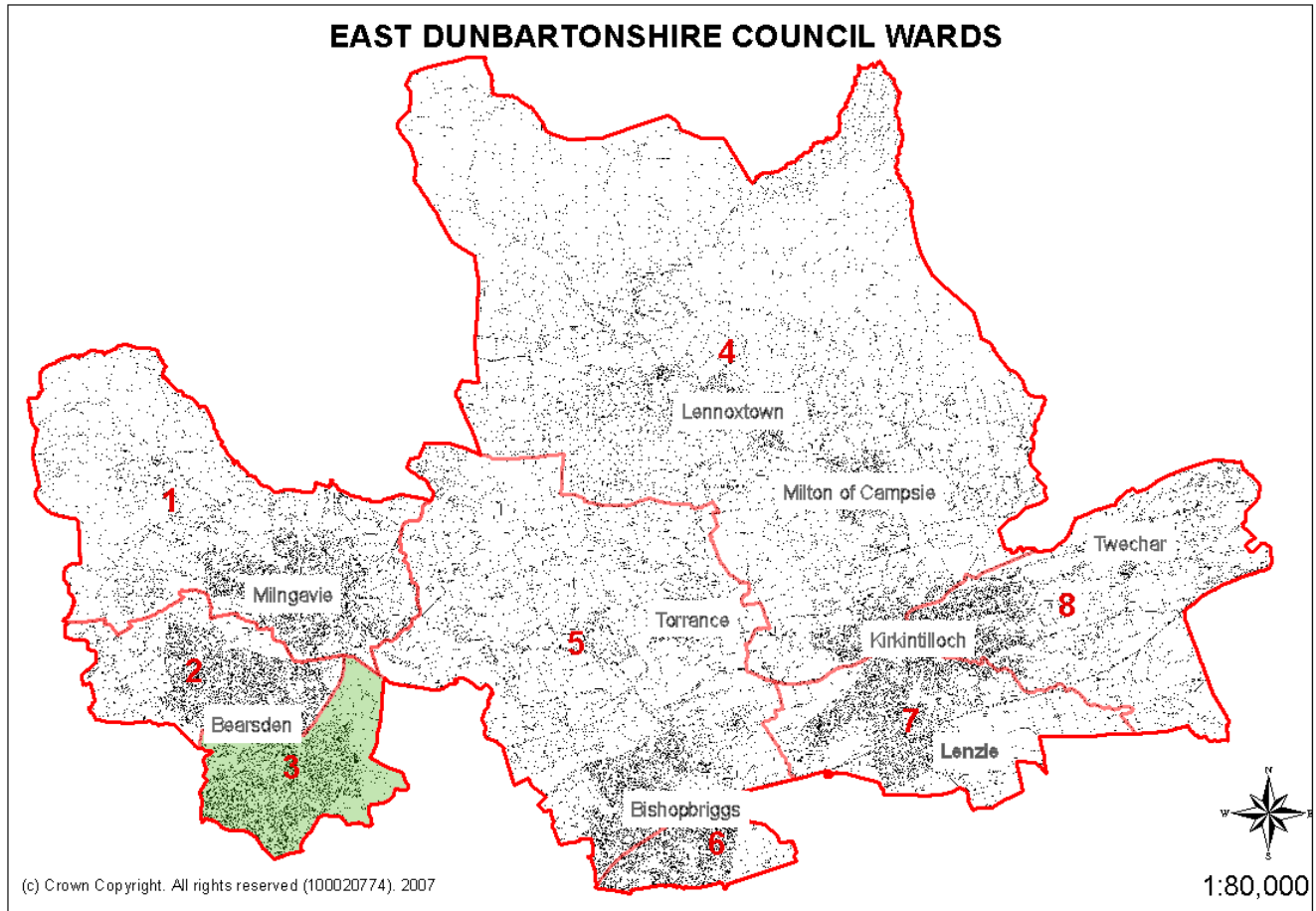

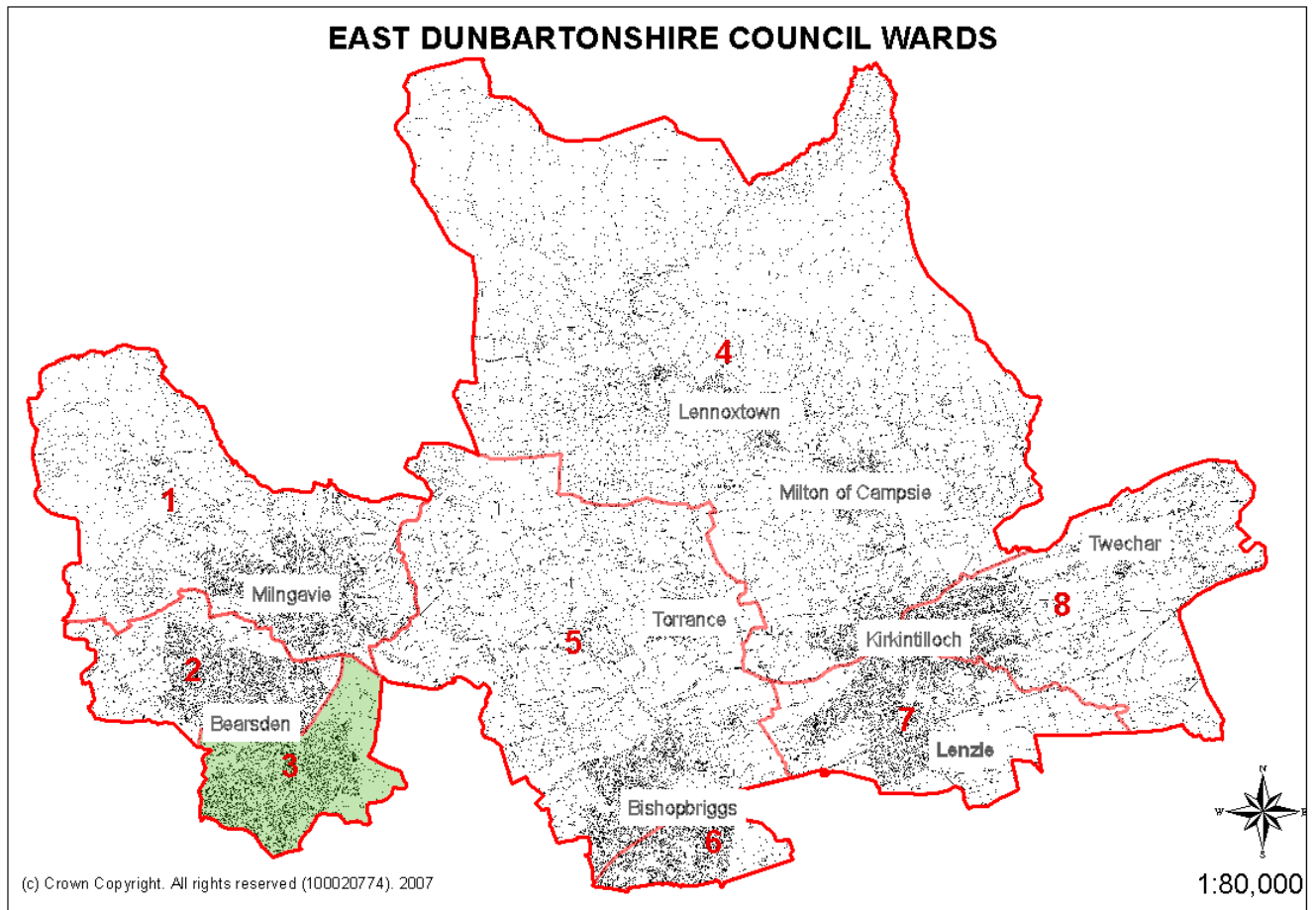

WARD 3 BEARSDEN SOUTH



Area

Ward 3 Bearsden South has a population of 13,021 (*National Records Scotland 2010 Mid Year Estimate*). There are 5,344 households with housing mainly comprising of detached (43.9%) and semi-detached (29.2%) dwellings.

There are 4 primary schools in Ward 3 (Bearsden, Colquhoun, Killermont and Westerton) and 1 secondary school (Boclair Academy). The average attendance rate for schools is 96.85% for primary schools and 94.45% for the secondary school. Boclair Academy has a higher number of positive school leaver destinations with the majority of pupils entering higher education.

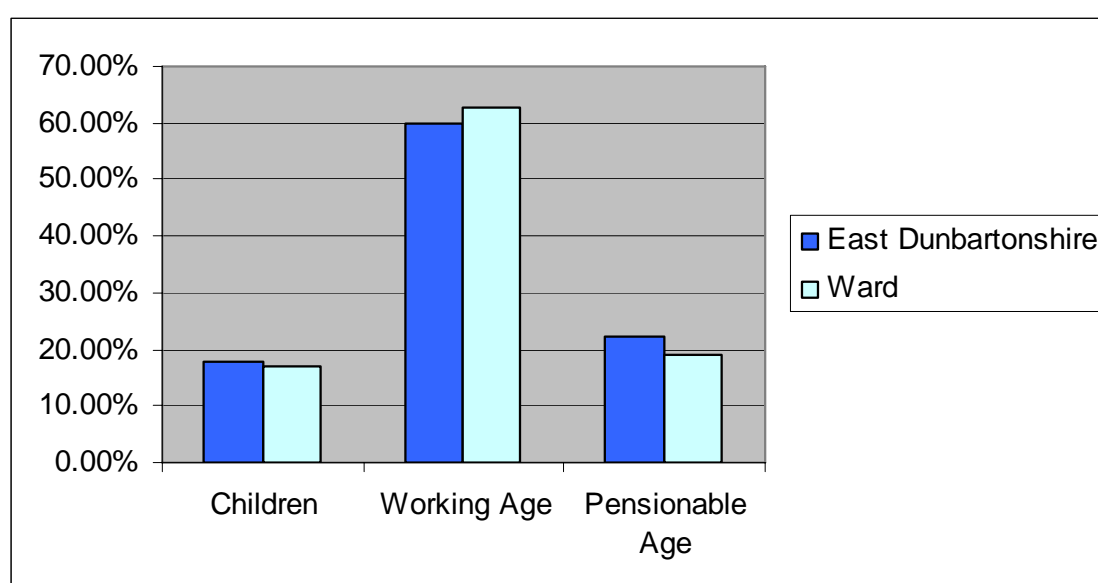

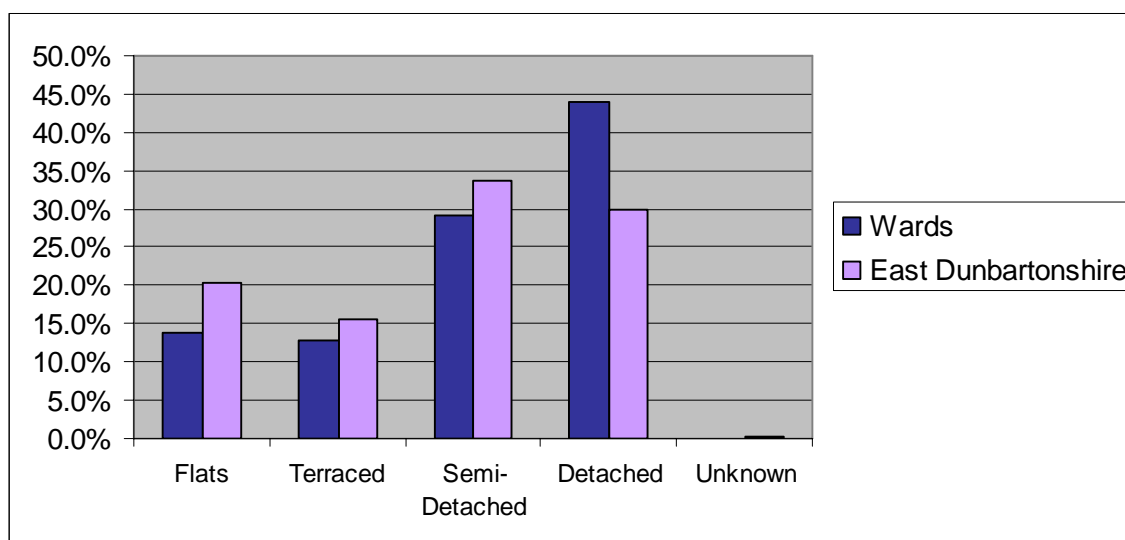

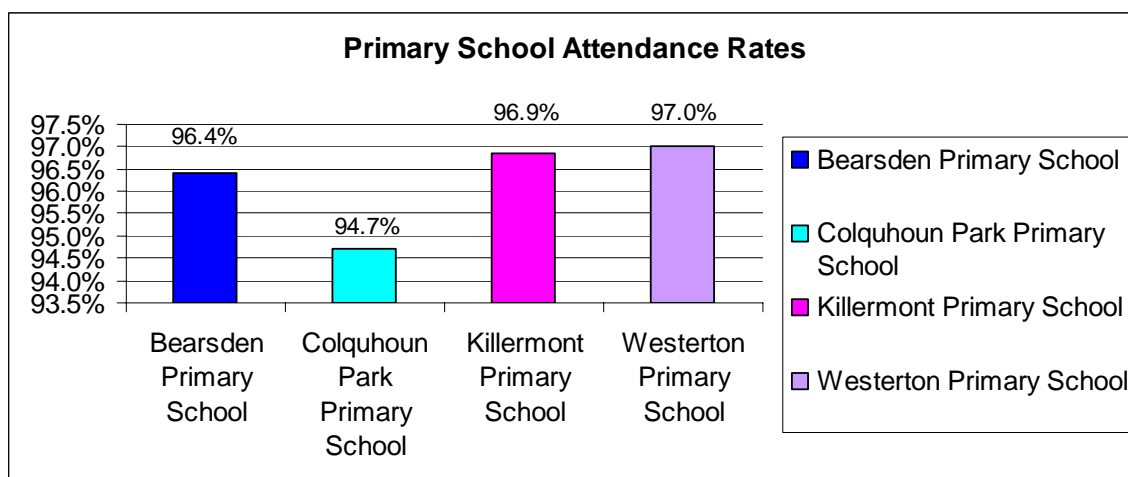
