Like his kinswoman, the celebrated Elizabeth Fry, he belonged to the 'Society of Friends', but, while he never scrupled, if expedient, to assert his own opinions, he was ever ready to acknowledge that others had an honest right to differ from him. Epitaphs on departed friends are often too laudatory, but I can testify to the truth of the inscription recited above, that 'his life was a living epistle of Peace, Love and Brotherhood,
