

- 1 FREMONT ROCKET**  
Cold War rocket, Fremont icon
- 2 LENIN STATUE**  
all the way from Poprad, Slovakia
- 3 "WAITING FOR THE INTERURBAN"**  
often-decorated community sculpture
- 4 HISTORY HOUSE**  
museum full of neighborhood histories and heritage
- 5 FREMONT TROLL**  
beware of what lurks under the Aurora Bridge!
- 6 GAS WORKS PARK**  
kite flying and city views at a former gas plant

- 7 WATERWAY 18**  
rare natural beach on an urban lake
- 8 WATERWAY 15**  
secluded park embedded with Seattle history
- 9 PEACE PARK**  
visit Sadako and the Thousand Cranes
- 10 "THE WALL OF DEATH"**  
public art based on a motorcycle circus stunt



- 11 EASTLAKE P-PATCH**  
a gardener's oasis in the city
- 12 EASTLAKE BOULEDROME**  
bring a friend for a game of petanque
- 13 LYNN STREET MINI PARK**  
see the tiles at Seattle's first street end park
- 14 "SHEAR DRAFT"**  
sculpture about aircraft and shipbuilding on Lake Union
- 15 PUGET SOUND MARITIME HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM**  
an exhibit of northwest maritime history



**CROSSING FREMONT BRIDGE**  
Pedestrians:  
use east side of bridge.  
Bicycles:  
northbound use east side;  
southbound cross Fremont Ave  
to use west side, then cross  
again to continue on trail.

**CROSSING UNIVERSITY BRIDGE**  
Pedestrians:  
use west side of bridge  
Bicycles:  
southbound use west side;  
northbound use east side, then  
follow pathway to the east  
and loop under bridge onto NE  
40th St.

- 16 THE CENTER FOR WOODEN BOATS**  
hands-on museum with boats of every  
shape and size
- 17 LAKE UNION PARK**  
water views, historic ships, and Seattle history
- 18 CROCKETT STREET END**  
Imagine yourself as a ship's captain
- 19 GARDEN WITH A SECRET**  
reveals the railroad history of Westlake Ave
- 20 WATERWAY 1**  
find bits of history on the railings and  
sidewalks between here and waterway 2
