Kissell in good shape

Raleigh, N.C. – Larry Kissell finds himself in a solid political position as he begins his second year in Congress, with a good approval rating and double digit leads over all of his potential 2010 opponents.

45% of Kissell's constituents approve of the job he's doing with 30% disapproving. He has a solid 58/21 breakdown with voters of his own party but maybe more impressive are his 40% approval with independents and 28% standing with Republicans, both of which are unusually high for Democratic elected officials right now.

Kissell leads a generic Republican opponent 53-39 and holds a 54-38 lead over Tim D'Annunzio, a 55-37 one over Lou Huddleston, a 53-39 advantage over Harold Johnson, and a 55-39 one against Hal Jordan.

None of the GOP candidates are very well known at this point. D'Annunzio leads the pack with 35% name recognition, followed by Johnson at 31% and Jordan and Huddleston at 26%.

52% of voters in the district are opposed to the Democratic health care bill with 35% in support. Only 29% of respondents were able to correctly note that Kissell voted against the bill with 44% thinking he voted for and it and 28% unsure.

"Larry Kissell's in a much better position than many Congressional Democrats in competitive districts," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "The eventual Republican nominee will have to run a very strong campaign if he's going to be defeated."

PPP surveyed 744 NC-8 voters from January 9th to 11th. The margin of error is +/-3.6%. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
