Since the game turned professional we have worked closely with the schools rugby administrators, trainers and coaches, sharing systems that have been the foundation of the professional game in Canterbury.

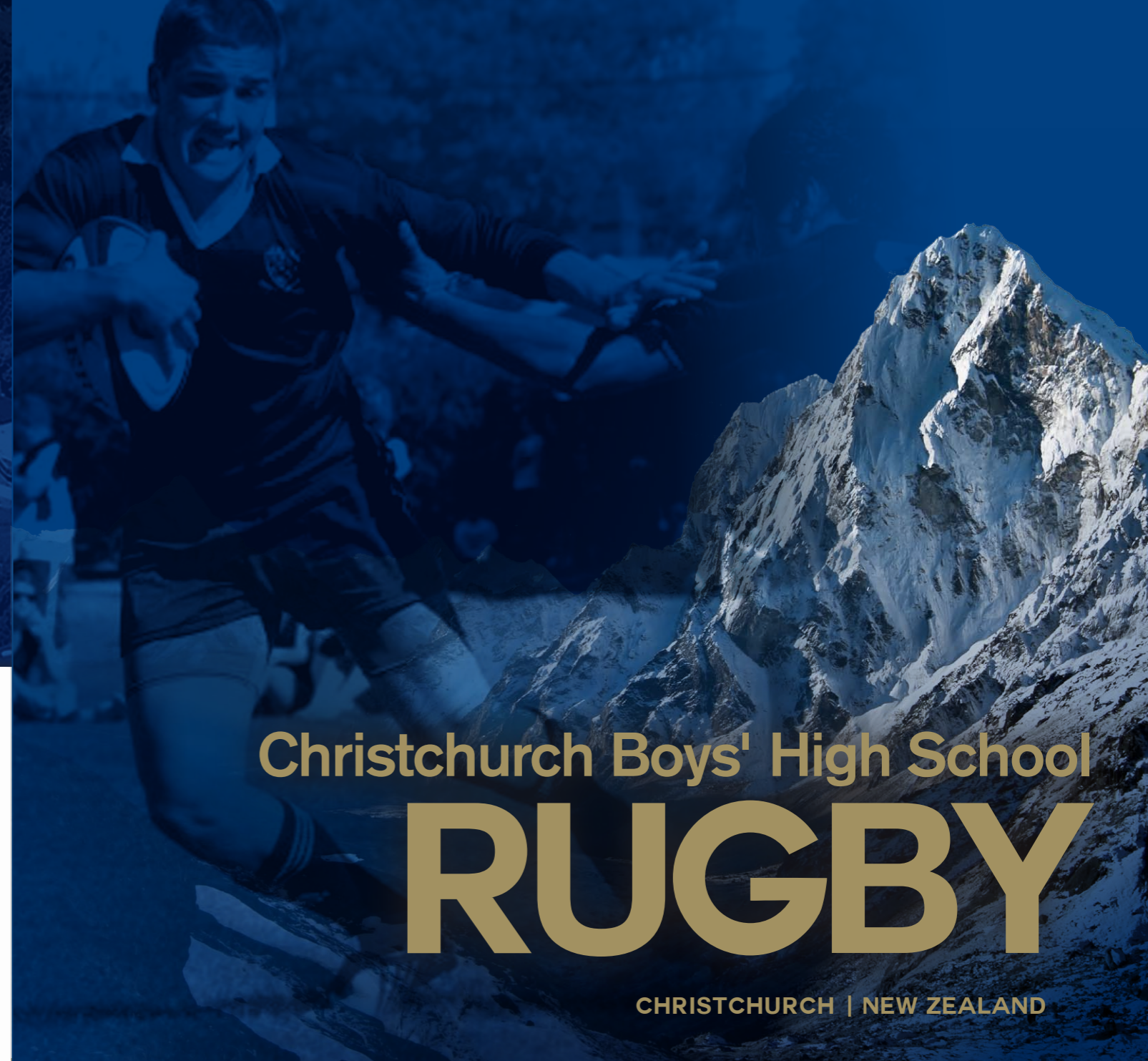
CBHS has produced an unprecedented number of professional players and coaches over its proud history including 20 Crusaders, 14 All Blacks and 2 All Black coaches.

## Rugby at Christchurch Boys' High School

Christchurch Boys' High School has been arguably the number one rugby school in the world since the sport became professional in 1996. CBHS has produced 45 All Blacks. Since 1996 no other school in the world has produced as many international players. During this time CBHS has produced 15 Allblacks, 3 Japan internationals, 1 USA, 1 Ireland and 2 Allblack coaches. The undefeated 2013 All Black squad contained 7 former CBHS players and the head coach. 65 former Christchurch Boys' High players have gone on to play professional rugby (since 1996).

The secret to the success of CBHS rugby has been based on our philosophy that academic endeavour and rugby excellence are dependent on each other. Our rugby programs focus on leadership, initiative, balance and the pursuit of excellence.

When students attend CBHS they will enter into a rugby community and a traditional boys' school with a proud history of success in many disciplines. They will leave CBHS as young men ready to accept the many challenges placed upon them in Rugby and in life outside of school.



### HEADMASTER'S WELCOME

Our vision is to be "a community educating each boy to be a fine young man." Welcome to that community. We have over 130 years experience in supporting the boys who enrol here to become fine young men. They excel across a wide range of academic, sporting and cultural pursuits. We honor tradition, we value excellence, we teach values and we celebrate success in a school environment that cares for student welfare, recognises cultural diversity and meets the learning needs of a wide range of students.

### OUR AIM

To challenge each pupil to realise his potential in the pursuit of academic, cultural and sporting excellence.

### ACADEMIC YEAR

There are four terms per year commencing beginning of February and finishing in early December. Students are accepted throughout the year.

### ENROLMENT

Students from years 9-13 are accepted. Academic reports are required from previous school and the level of English required will be tested upon arrival.

### ACCOMMODATION

Our homestay programme provides the international students with quality accommodation and a caring environment to support the student during their time at Christchurch Boys' High School. These homestays are monitored and closely supervised by our school recognised Guardians.

### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SUPPORT

Quality care and support of our international students is provided by a full time International Director, International Student Learning Facilitator and an International Administration Manager in academic pathway and personal achievement to produce fine young men.

### GUARDIANSHIP

All students must have a school approved guardian and access is provided to a speaker in their native language. All guardians liaise closely with the International Director.
