

The Florida Board of Bar Examiners, through its Chair, the Honorable Daryl M. Manning of Tampa, Florida, has announced that the grades from the July 2015 General Bar Examination have been approved for release by the Supreme Court of Florida.

On July 28-29, 2015, 3,448 applicants took the Bar Examination in Tampa, Florida. The Supreme Court posted the pass/fail results for each applicant on its website and score reports were mailed to each applicant today.

The Court approved 1,621 candidates for admission to The Florida Bar on September 21, 2015, and Chief Justice Jorge Labarga has announced that they may be sworn in as members of The Florida Bar. Formal induction ceremonies to swear in the new attorneys will be held at the Supreme Court of Florida and the Second, Third, Fourth, and Fifth District Courts of Appeal on Wednesday, October 7, 2015.
