2. Authority	The Board shall support a program of career and technical education which may include:

SC 1809	3. Enrollment of students in a shared-time program of career and technical education outside this district, provided that such program is not offered in this district and enrollment has been approved by the parent/guardian of the student.

557.14	All students participating in career and technical education programs supervised by the Board or in shared-time programs shall be considered regularly enrolled in district schools and shall be subject to the polices and rules of the Board and jointly established policies and rules of the district and the Career and Technology Center of Lackawanna County, including rules regarding attendance for those periods when students are not assigned to outside work projects or other classes.

		4. Development of district career and technical education programs is integrated with a continuing assessment of the employment demands of the community, state and world economy, as well as the needs and interests of students.
		The Superintendent shall seek and utilize all available state and federal sources of revenue for the financial support of career and technical education programs.
