



Used to find information and research, but, limited use as recruitment, networking, or promotion tool




IMPACT IN NEXT 5 YEARS?

BACK TO THE 'IDENTITY 1.0' PROBLEM

- Finding author-related information is one of the most common search patterns.
- An author's scientific production and impact are keys to funding, promotion, tenure, etc.
- Author searching in databases was hampered by two serious problems:
 - How to distinguish between an author's articles and those of another authors sharing the same name?
 - How to group an author's articles together when his or her name has been recorded in different ways?

POSSIBLE APPROACHES


Three possible approaches:

- User-created
- Authority file
- Algorithm

How did we approach this?

- Top down approach: algorithm using data in records.
- Incorporating a 'bottom up' aspect by including feedback on where our matching algorithm and data need improvement.



WHAT HAVE WE LEARNED

- In general, librarians, authors and end-users are extremely positive and understanding of errors.
 - 99% precision and 95% recall across 30M+ publications provides sufficient user value,
 - But continuous improvements are essential, because
 - 10K+ corrections is nice, but those won't bridge the gap to 100% perfect bibliography


