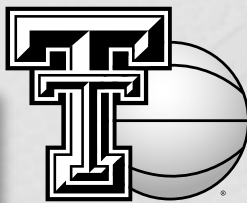

JUNIOR (2005-2006)

Darryl averaged 7.6 points per game and 4.6 rebounds per game for the season... started 26 of the 30 games he played... averaged 28.5 minutes per game...played 40 minutes against Georgia Southern and Texas A&M...played 45 minutes in the overtime win at home against Oklahoma State...third on the team in assists(89)... established a career best of 7 assists against Texas A&M...had 8 games with 5(or more) assists...third in scoring and second in rebounding on the squad...had 7 games with at least 7 rebounds...shot .437 (87-of-199) from the field for the season which was second on the team for those players taking 50 FG attempts...made 35-of-41 free throw attempts (.854) and was perfect from the line in 8 games (including 8-of-8 against Furman) totaling 24 points...made at least one three-pointer in 14 games... scored in double figures in 8 games.

SOPHOMORE (2004-2005)

Canned a three-pointer with 4 seconds remaining in the second overtime period to give the Red Raiders their 80-79 win over Kansas on Valentine's Day at the United Spirit Arena...played 36 minutes, was 3-of-7 from the field – including 1-of-5 3FG attempts, made 4-of-5 FT attempts, and scored 11 points...played in each game during the season...started 24 games and averaged 26 minutes-per-game...started 13

conference games...played every minute in four games... averaged 6.2 ppg and 4.2 rpg for the season...tallied double-figures in 10 games – with a season best of 14 points at Baylor...pulled down 7 (or more) rebounds in 8 games...made all 14 FT attempts over a span of 5 games...dished out a career best 6 assists against SMU.

FRESHMAN (2003-2004)

Darryl played 18 minutes in his Red Raider debut against Davidson in the first game of the Pre-season NIT...he scored 3 points, grabbed 2 rebounds, registered 2 blocks and 1 steal...played in 33 games during the 34-game season and averaged 14 minutes per game...played 15 minutes (or more) in 16 games and played 20 minutes (or more) in 10 games... started 7 games...averaged 3.3 points per game for the season... registered season-highs of 15 points and 29 minutes of court action in a starting role against Minnesota on New Year's Day...made 5-of-7 field goal attempts (including 2-of-2 three-point attempts), 3-of-4 free throw attempts, grabbed 3 rebounds, had 1 assist and 2 steals to start the New Year...tallied double-figures in three games...14 points vs. San Diego State...15 points vs. Minnesota...12 points against Charlotte ...averaged 2.6 rebounds for the season...notched a double-double (12 points and 10 rebounds) against Charlotte in the NCAA Tournament at

the HSBC Arena in Buffalo, New York...canned 4-of-6 field goal attempts, sunk all four free throw attempts, had 6 assists, and made 2 steals in the Red Raider win (76-73) over Charlotte.

HIGH SCHOOL

A graduate of Gonzales High School in Gonzales, Texas...basketball coach was David Peavy...Darryl was named District 29-3A MVP as a senior...averaged 18.2 points and 10.5 rebounds per game as a senior... in his junior season, Darryl averaged 16 points per game and 10.4 rebounds per game...All-Area selection by the Victoria Advocate...led the Gonzales Apaches to the Class 3A regional final as a junior.

JUNIOR (2005-2006)

Led the Big 12 Conference (all games) in scoring last season with 20.5 ppg... led the Big 12 Conference (conference games only) in scoring with 21.7 ppg... ranked 21st nationally in 2005-2006 season scoring average...first in the conference in 3-Point FG percentage on 73-of-163 (44.8%)...third in the conference in FT percentage on 152-of-187 (81.3%)...conference leading and individual game high of 41 points at Nebraska...All-Big 12 First Team...USBWA All-District 7 Team...All-Tournament Team for the 2005 2K Sports College Hoops Classic benefiting Coaches vs. Cancer...scored double figures in 30-of-32 games...has scored 1,544 career points which ranks 11th among all Texas Tech players...657 points this season ranks as the 4th best individual single-season in Texas Tech history (Andre Emmett: 1st and 3rd with 741 points and 701 points. Rick Bullock: 2nd with 708 points)...53 steals last season is 6th best for a single-season... has 150 career steals (4th all-time for Texas Tech)...led the conference and team with 38.38 minutes played per game...only player on the squad to start each game in the 2005-2006 season...team leader with 93 assists...registered his first double-double with 12 rebounds and 22 points against Missouri...perfect from the free throw line in 8 games totaling 38 points.

SOPHOMORE (2004-2005)

Jay was the only player on the 2004-2005 squad to start each of the 33 games...second on the team with 15.3 ppg...scored at least 20 points in 8 games - with career-best of 32 points at Oklahoma...averaged 34.1 minutes-per-game and played 40 minutes in 9 games...played 49-of-50 minutes in the double-overtime win against Kansas...was second on the team with 127 free-throw attempts and second with 102 successful tries (.803)...perfect from the free-throw line in 11 games for a combined 34-for-34 record...made 12-of-15 attempts against Colorado - both career highs...team leader with 114 assists (3.5 apg)...third on the squad with 35 steals...leading three-point shooter on the squad (44-for-96, .458)...12th in the conference (all-games and conference only) in scoring average...8th overall in the conference in FG percentage (.470)...7th overall in conference FT percentage (.803)...Big 12 Player of the Week (Feb. 7)...All-Big 12 Third Team.

FRESHMAN (2003-2004)

Played in all 34 games in the season...started 32 games during the season... averaged 32.5 minutes per game...had 16 games of at least 35 minutes of court action...second on the team in scoring with an average of 11.3 ppg...scored in double-figures 19 times... had 12 games of 15 (or more) points... registered a season-high of 22 points at

OSU...shot .500 (or higher) from the field in 12 games...had 11 games in which he was perfect (total: 40-for-40) from the free-throw line...had three games in which he went 6-for-6 from the line (TCU, at OSU, and Charlotte)...had 22 games in which he sank a three-point shot...canned three 3-pointers in four games...team leader with 62 steals...his 62 steals holds down the top spot on the Red Raider individual single-season list...selected to the Big 12's All-Freshman team.

JUNIOR (2005-2006)

Played in 19 games this season and had three starts...averaged nearly 9 minutes per game and averaged 2.8 ppg for the season...played 20 minutes (or more) in four games and contributed 28 points in those games...made one three-pointer (or more) in 11 games...against Kansas State in the Big 12 Championship, Tanner played 23 minutes and scored 14 points on 5-of-7 field goal attempts (including 2-of-4 three-pointers), made 2-of-3 free throws, had 3 rebounds, and handed out 3 assists...in a starting role the following day against Texas, he grabbed 8 rebounds, dished out 6 assists, and scored on a three-pointer...improved career performances in eight categories...graduated in May 2006 with a Bachelor of Arts in Communication Studies and is now attending graduate school.

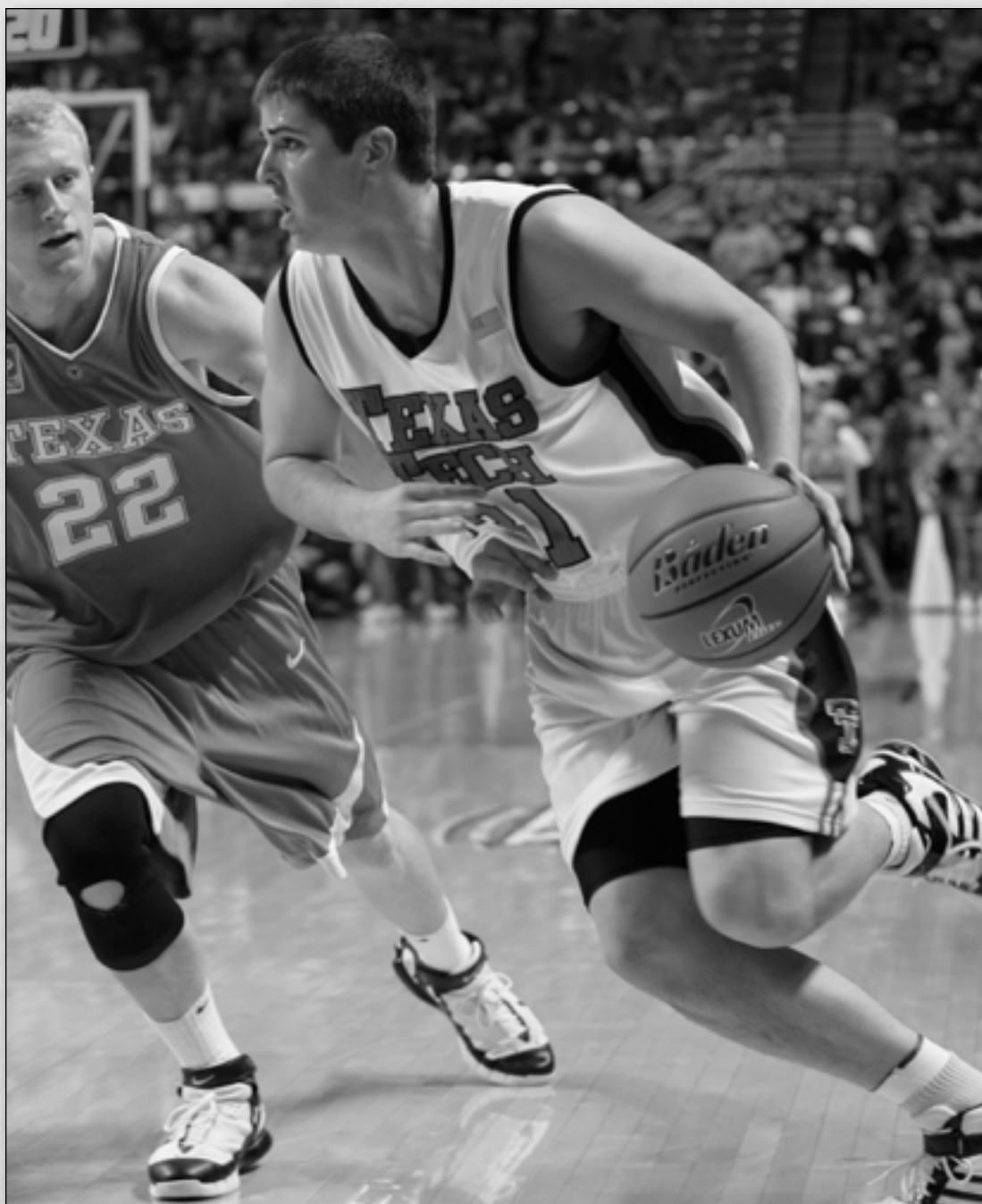
HIGH SCHOOL

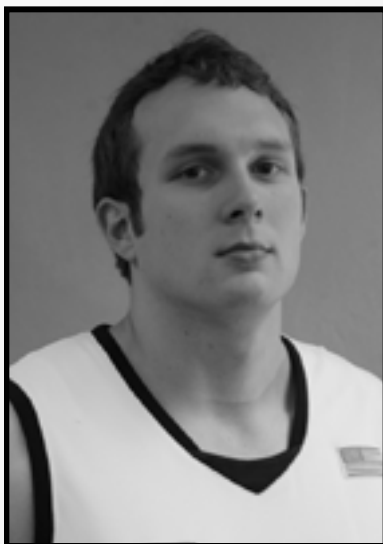

JUNIOR (2005-2006)

Played and started his first game as a Red Raider in the season opener against San Jose State...in 29 minutes, Jon scored 15 points making 6-of-8 shots from the field and 3-of-3 from the free throw line... he also had 8 rebounds and a block in the SJSU game...played in 27 games and started 23 games...averaged 6.2 points per game and 4.1 rebounds per game for the season...scored double figures in 8 games – including 16 points at home against Kansas State...averaged 21.6 minutes per game and played at least 30 minutes in three games...perfect from the free throw line in seven games totaling 22 points – including 6-of-6 against TCU...Jon's .764 from the free throw line for the season was 2nd among squad members with at least 50 free throw attempts...drafted by the Los Angeles Angels in the 47th round of the 2006 MLB First-year Player Draft.

SOPHOMORE (2004-2005)

JUNIOR (2005-2006)

LucQuente played in 17 games and started seven of those games...averaged 2.0 ppg and 14.8 minutes per game for the season...started the season opener against San Jose State and scored 3 points and had 3 rebounds before injuring his knee...injury kept him out of action until conference play...started and played 35 minutes in the 92-90 overtime win over Oklahoma State...registered 9 points, 3 rebounds, 4 assists, and 3 steals in the OSU game.

SOPHOMORE (2004-2005)
