Quick Stocking Hat

Size:

Adult: Small, (Medium, Large) Circumference: 15" (17", 20")

These fit loose around the ribbing and have a lot of stretch to them. For a tighter fit use a smaller needle for

the ribbing.

Materials:

Size 10 US 16" circular needle and size 10 US DPNs 1 skein of Berroco Peruvia Quick Stitch marker Darning needle

Abbreviations:

K - Knit

P - Purl

K2tog - Knit two stitches together

PM - Place marker

DPNs - Double Point Needles



Directions:

With circular needles, cast on 56 (64, 72) stitches.

PM to indicate beginning of round. Join, being careful not to twist the stitches and knit every round in 2X2 rib (*K2, P2 - repeat to end of round*) for 2.5" from cast on edge.

Switching to the knit stitch, knit for 5" (5 $\frac{1}{2}"$, 6").

Begin decreases:

Round 1: *K6, K2TOG*

Round 2: Knit

Round 3:*K5, K2TOG*

Round 4: Knit Switching to DPNs as needed.

Round 5: *K4, K2TOG*

Round 6: Knit

Round 7: *K3, K2TOG*

Round 8: Knit

Round 9: *K2, K2TOG*

Round 10: Knit

Round 11: *K1, K2TOG* **Round 12:** *K2TOG*

Cut yarn leaving a 4-5 inch long tail and thread onto a needle. Pull needle through remaining stitches and pull tightly to close hole. Turn hat inside out and weave ends in. Pom pom optional.
