Property Description

The main ditch of the fortress originally spanned from near St Martin Demibastion down to the flank of the low battery. Today it starts from near the salient of St Michael Bastion. A nineteenth-century water reservoir was built into the ditch at the foot of the right face of St Michael Bastion. The ditch has the same level from St Michael Bastion all the way to the middle of the curtain wall linking St Michael Bastion to St John Demi-bastion, where it then descends steeply to a reach a lower level at the foot of St John Bastion. Rough rocky scarps form the footing of the wing of St John Demi-bastion. The entrance of what is thought to have been a tunnel cut beneath the bastion in 1645 opens in this rocky scarps.


