Property Description	The tower is a small plain structure which was built by the knight Fra Bernardo Macedonia, Commander of Artillery of the Order, in 1613. The tower is known as the Saint Cecilia Tower after the name of a nearby medieval chapel. The tower has a rectangular plan and crowned by decorative finials and other retardataire decorative features. It is currently used as a private residence.
