Welcome to your new train timetable

All trains in this timetable are ScotRail services operated by Abellio, except where otherwise shown. We aim to make your train journey as easy as possible and are continuing to improve services across the Network. In the West Highlands the first Glasgow to/from Oban train will now run additionally on Saturdays. Seven new stations will open in the Scottish Borders from 6 September with Edinburgh to Newcraighall trains extended to Tweedbank. This will also include an hourly Sunday service throughout the day. From 17 May a similar Sunday service will be introduced from Edinburgh to Newcraighall and an hourly Sunday service will commence between Glasgow and Paisley Canal. Duke Street, Alexandra Parade and Barnhill stations will also benefit from a Sunday service with trains running hourly between Partick and Cumbernauld.

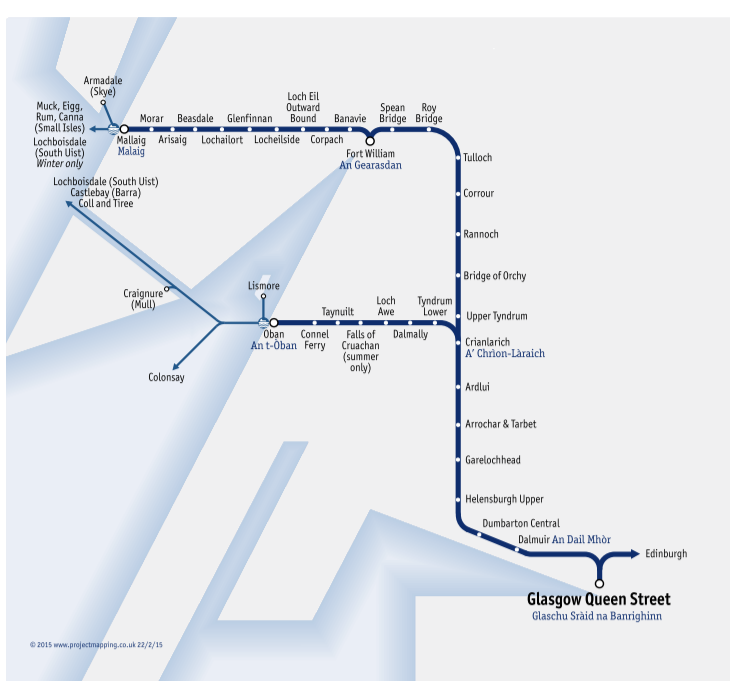
Please note that trains may divide en route – check with staff that you are in the correct portion of the train.
