"They had the ball an awful lot. I think that we made some big plays and that was what won it for us. I don't know everyone who made a big play. I know that Wayne Adkinson came from a mile away to cover on that halfback pass they threw.

"I probably made a mistake in not substituting more. Some of our ~~physical~~ people got tired in the fourth quarter. But we felt that we had to have them in there so much.

"We had some people hurt that we lost for awhile during the game. Masao, of course, Adkinson, Beard. And of course Wade didn't play at all.

"We've got to get patched up and get our offense straightened out. Our defense gave us the ball enough that we should have scored, but LSU was too tough for us."
