LSU HEAD COACH GERRY DINARDO

General Thoughts:

"I thought the most significant thing was that a year ago we were in the same situation. We didn't play very good against South Carolina. So we talked all week about it. This team has responded to every situation thus far, and they did tonight. So I was happy with that. We were awful sloppy in the second half. But, we'll have some things to work on this week. But it was a great win because we are 2-0 in the conference and 4-0 for the first time since 1978. 4-0 and seven (wins) in a row, and all those kind of things which are important, which we emphasized during the week. But the most significant thing is that we've grown in a year. We're not flat when we think we just have to show up. I give our players a lot of credit. They did what they had to do to win the game."

On facing his former team, and many of his recruits:

"Well, I said during the week that is was different. It's still different now. Still don't know how I feel. Again, what's important is that we're 4-0. That takes precedent. It's not personal."

Why wear gold jerseys instead of purple?

"I want to start up a new tradition. We've started a couple of traditions, and we already have a lot of traditions to honor, and we'll continue to honor. But, we've started a couple of our own within the team meetings, and this is one we wanted to start. And we felt this is the uniform we want to wear."

Are the gold jerseys now your "dark" jerseys?

"Yeah, right now they will be, and so we're going to approach it that way. I think it proves that the purple pants were not to blame for losing last year (at Kentucky)."

On Kevin Faulk and Rondell Mealy's play:

"Rondell and Kevin both played well. We had a good mix in there."

Was this Herb Tyler's best overall game?

"Herb played well...I don't know about it being his best game...He played very well at Auburn."

Importance of the defensive shutout:

"It's significant. When you get a goal-line stand like that, it's significant."

Did you warn the players about a fake field goal attempt:

"About eight coaches beat me to it, so I didn't have to."

Kendall Cleveland's injury:

"Bruised knee, but not ligaments."

VANDERBILT HEAD COACH ROD DOWHOWER

"They're a very talented football team. You've got to give them credit; they've got good runners, and in the first half, they were at their best."

"They have lots of team speed and a lot of good athletes. We would have to be at our very best to compete with them."

"Give them credit. They're every bit as good as Notre Dame and Alabama, and they have better speed than both of them."

(on the jerseys)

"We have the power of choice and we made the choice to wear our white jerseys. Looks like it upset a few people. I don't know about as far as on the field and all that business, but give LSU credit, they're a pretty darn good football team. I doubt jerseys had much to do with that. What should I regret? This has nothing to do with what happens between those white lines. That is all hype."

COMMODORE RB ALVIN DUKE

"They were ready to play, and they played a mistake-free ball game. Their defense really stepped it up."

"We have to get ready for next week (North Texas)."

"They stepped it up. We tried to make adjustments at halftime, but unfortunately, they didn't work out."

VANDY QB DAMION ALLEN

"I thought we came into the game with the right mindset. It seems like it would have taken our best to beat those guys. They've got some great athletes."

"We made some minor adjustments (at halftime), but basically we kept the same game plan."

DT MATT SCHUCKMAN

"I don't think we executed well. We didn't keep the men in front of us one-on-one, and that will never do."

"Both he (Faulk) and Mealey are the two best running backs we've faced so far and will probably be the two best we play against all year."

"We thought we could do some things to stop them. On paper, that stuff will work and we did a good a job of executing that at practice but we didn't come out here and execute it here when it counted."

LSU Player Quotes:

Allen Stansberry, Linebacker

"This win means a lot to us. To get the shut out was very nice, especially heading into next week's game, where we know we're going to be tested."

"We learned from last year's mistakes that we can't take anyone lightly. We remember games like South Carolina and Kentucky and we didn't want to repeat that. We've got enough to worry about with Florida next week to let games that we should win slip away."

Kevin Faulk, Running Back

"We wanted to come in here tonight and be able to run the ball effectively and then set up the pass and we were able to do just that, this was a good offensive performance."

"This win gives us some momentum going into next week's game because we're going to have to execute like we did tonight to have a chance to win."

Herb Tyler, Quarterback

"I think we just came out ready to play tonight. We had a lot more on the line than they did. We played hard and stayed focused for four quarters and got a nice win tonight."

"A win like this is nice because it shows how far we have come as a team. We're more focused on what we have to do and we go out and take care of business each week."

## LSU GAME NOTES

\* LSU is off to its first 4-0 start since starting 1973 9-0. The Tigers have now also won seven in a row dating back to last year.

\* LSU has won four straight conference games dating back to last year, the first time they have done so since winning five straight in 1988.

\* LSU has now won six straight home games, their longest streak since reeling off eight straight in 1976 and '77. LSU is now 8-1 at home under Gerry DiNardo. By comparison, Curley Hallman won only nine home games in his four-year career as head coach.

\* LSU shut out Vanderbilt for the first time since a 14-0 win in 1946.

\* The 35-point margin is the largest margin of victory in an SEC game by the Tigers since a 47-0 whitewash of Mississippi State in 1986.

\* The crowd of 80,142 was the fifth largest in Tiger Stadium history and the second crowd of 80,000 this season. It's also the largest crowd to ever see LSU and Vanderbilt play. Of the five crowds of 80,000 or more, only one has not been in the DiNardo era, and that's the record crowd of 82,390 against Washington in 1983.

\* Herb Tyler is now 8-0 as the Tigers' starting quarterback. The last quarterback to win his first eight starts was Mike Miley, who directed the Tigers to that 9-0 start in '73.

\* Tyler's 53 yard completion to Larry Foster in the third quarter was the longest of the season. It was also Foster's longest career reception. Tyler has now passed for multiple touchdowns in back-to-back games for the first time in his career.

\* Kevin Faulk rushed for 114 yards, the second time he has broken the century mark this season and the sixth time in his career.

\* Mark Roman intercepted two passes.

\* Rondell Mealey has now scored seven touchdowns (6 rushing, 1 receiving) in his first four collegiate games. The last Tiger to do so was Dalton Hilliard, who scored nine (5 rush, 4 receiving) in 1982.

\* Wade Richey has made 23 straight extra points without a miss in his career.
