

but it was window-dressing; the Tigs doubled their score with three more six-pointers; another by Robiskie and two by frosh galloper Charles Alexander—the latter after LSU's sixth interception of the evening. Burrell tied a school record with three of the swipes and Leonard had a pair. Although the LSU ground defense was uniformly stalwart, Bordelon racked up three QB sacks for another LSU one-season mark: 21 CBL's for total losses of 122 yards. Still a third team record was put on the books by tackle Cassidy, whose 83 solo stops were the most ever by a Tiger defensive lineman. Offensively, Alexander and Robiskie had 81 and 78 yards rushing, respectively, while Lyons was hitting 7 of 10 tosses for 114 yards and two scores.
