Outline Description	Lodge connected to Law Courts
Property Description	<p>This building used to house the town criers who announced the decrees issued by the Town Council for the people of used to gather in the piazza. The loggia, which stylistically has been dated to the 17th century, consists of three semicircular arches which serve as a base for the balustraded open balcony above which is accessed via the Corte Capitanale. In the 18th century, de Mondion skillfully integrated the loggia into the Law Courts, and bridged this building to the Xara Palace on the other side of the square. Above the central doorway of the balcony, a coat-of-arms, now defaced, used to decorate the centerpiece.</p>

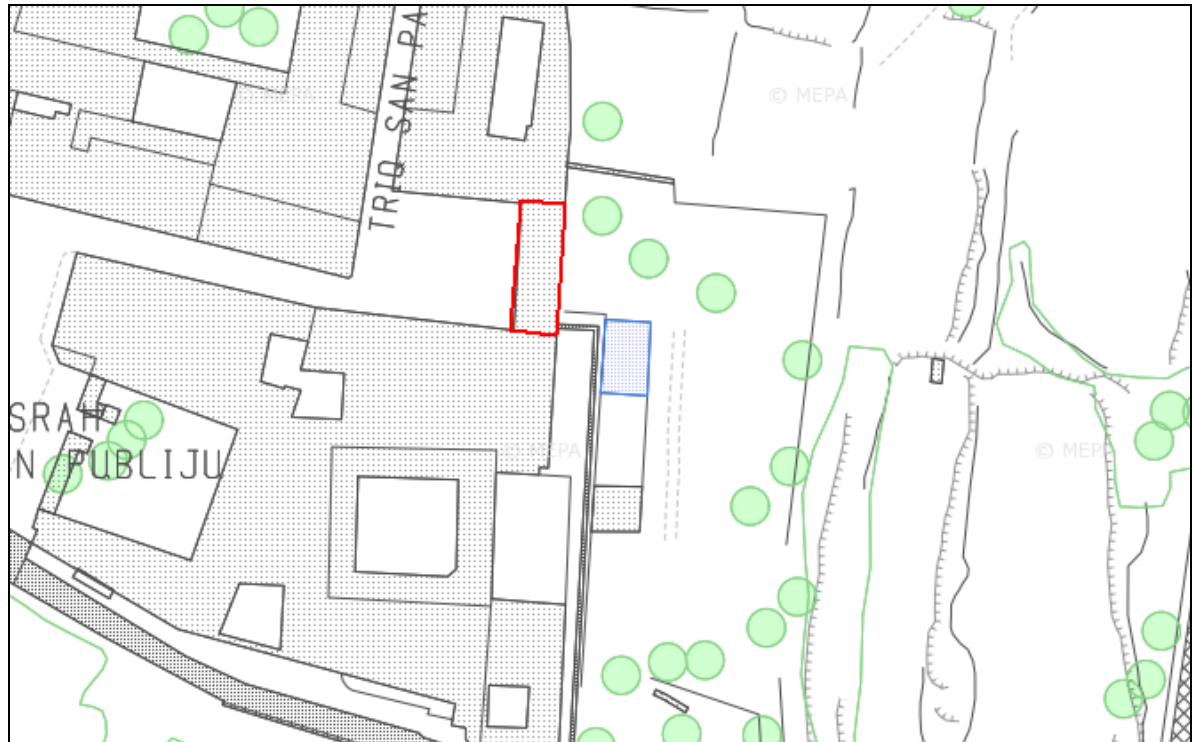
