In addition to the work that has informed the Trust's response to the Government's green paper and contained in Annexes A-F, the Trust has commissioned or is in the process of delivering the following pieces of work to Government to further inform the Charter Review debate:

- Audience views from the BBC Trust seminar series.
- Independent analysis looking at enhancing the independence of the BBC, conducted by the Policy Institute at King's College London.
- Results and analysis of the BBC Trust consultation about the BBC's proposals for the next Charter in British Bold Creative.
- Analysis of the BBC Trust consultation about the BBC's supply arrangements for the production of the BBC's television content, radio content and online content and services.
- Conclusions of the BBC Trust's reviews of the operation of its fair trading policy to inform future governance and oversight of fair trading compliance.
- Early indications of findings from the BBC Trust's review of transfer pricing arrangements.
- Perceptions of the value of the BBC.

These will all be made public in due course.
