

FRONT UPPER SUSPENSION ARM (for 2WD)


COMPONENTS



REMOVAL

- 1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL
- 2. REMOVE FRONT WHEEL
- 3. INSPECT FRONT SUSPENSION UPPER ARM
 - (a) Check that there is no slack on the ball joint by shaking the upper arm up and down by hand.
- 4. SEPARATE SKID CONTROL SENSOR WIRE
 - (a) Remove the speed sensor connector.
 - (b) Remove the 2 bolts, and separate the skid control sensor wire.






5. SEPARATE FRONT FLEXIBLE HOSE

(a) Remove the bolt, and separate the front flexible hose.

6. REMOVE FRONT SUSPENSION UPPER ARM

- (a) Support the front suspension lower arm with a jack.
- (b) Remove the clip and nut.
- (c) Using SST, separate the upper ball joint from the steering knuckle.

- (e) Remove the front suspension upper arm.
