
- **PRECAUTION**
- DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY **TERMINAL**

Wait for at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable to prevent the airbag from working.

- PLACE FRONT WHEELS FACING STRAIGHT AHEAD
- **REMOVE NO.2 LOWER STEERING WHEEL COVER** (See page SR-9)
- **REMOVE NO.3 LOWER STEERING WHEEL COVER** (See page SR-9)
- REMOVE STEERING PAD (See page RS-558)
- REMOVE STEERING WHEEL ASSEMBLY (See page **SR-9**)




- (a) Remove the 2 screws.
- (b) Disengage the 2 claws to remove the steering column cover lower.



REMOVE UPPER STEERING COLUMN COVER

(a) Disengage the claw, then remove the upper steering column cover.



10. REMOVE SPIRAL CABLE SUB-ASSEMBLY

(a) Disconnect the airbag connector and the connector from the spiral cable sub-assembly.

NOTICE:

When handling the airbag connector, take care not to damage the airbag with harness.

(b) Disengage the 3 claws and remove the spiral cable sub-assembly.



INSPECTION

- 1. INSPECT SPIRAL CABLE SUB-ASSEMBLY
 - (a) If any of the following conditions is identified, replace the spiral cable sub-assembly with a new one.

Condition:

Scratches or cracks on the connector Cracks, dents or chipping of the spiral cable sub-assembly
