


NOTICE:

- If the wiring connector for the SRS is disconnected with the ignition switch in the ON position, DTCs will be recorded.
- Never use SRS parts from another vehicle. When replacing the parts, replace them with new ones.
- Never reuse a seat position sensor if an airbag has previously deployed in a collision.
- 1. DISCONNECT CABLE FROM NEGATIVE BATTERY TERMINAL

Wait for at least 90 seconds after disconnecting the cable to prevent the airbag from working.

- 2. REMOVE FRONT SEAT INNER BELT ASSEMBLY LH (See page SB-12)
- 3. REMOVE FRONT SEAT INNER BELT ASSEMBLY RH (See page SB-12)
- 4. REMOVE FRONT SEAT HEADREST ASSEMBLY (See page SE-53)
- 5. REMOVE FRONT SEAT ASSEMBLY (See page SE-53)
- 6. REMOVE SEAT POSITION SENSOR PROTECTOR (for RHD)
 - (a) Remove the seat slide position sensor protector from the seat position airbag sensor.
- 7. REMOVE SEAT POSITION SENSOR (for RHD)
 - (a) Disconnect the connector from the seat position sensor.
 - (b) Using "Torx" socket wrench T30, remove the "Torx" screw and the seat position sensor.

- (a) Disconnect the connector from the seat position sensor.
- (b) Using "Torx" socket wrench T30, remove the "Torx" screw and the seat position sensor.
