- Pierrot Yarns Aspen 3 [100% cashmere; 107 yds/98m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #14 charcoal gray; 6 skeins [140g]
- 3.0mm (US 2½), 3.3mm (approx. US 3), and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (15mm (5/8") diameter)
- tapestry needle

Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 33 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with 3.3mm needles): 28 sts and 33 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with 3.0mm needles): 37 sts and 33 rows

Finished measurements


- chest 91.5cm/36.02"
- cross back width 42cm/16.54"
 - length 62cm/24.41"


Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work according to schematics in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch. Shape armscyes and neckline with fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from edge) and by binding off stitches.

Finishing: Join shoulders with slip stitch, and join sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around armscye and work k1p1 ribbing in the round, then bind off in pattern. For front plackets, cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in k1p1 ribbing. Work buttonholes in designated places in left front placket; bind off in pattern. Attach front plackets to body with mattress stitch. Fasten buttons to right front placket.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on; DPNs = double pointed needles; N = needles; PU = pick up; R = row(s)/round(s); RE = row(s) even
