

# 211s-40 Pastel Color Nap Vest



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pastel Color Nap [40% rayon, 39% linen, 21% cotton; 55 yds/50m per 1.23 oz./35g skein];
  - color #1 white, 5 skeins [150g]
  - color #10 light brown, 2 skeins [70g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- length 50cm/19.69"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: approximately 3.5 nets and 10 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Crochet Tips

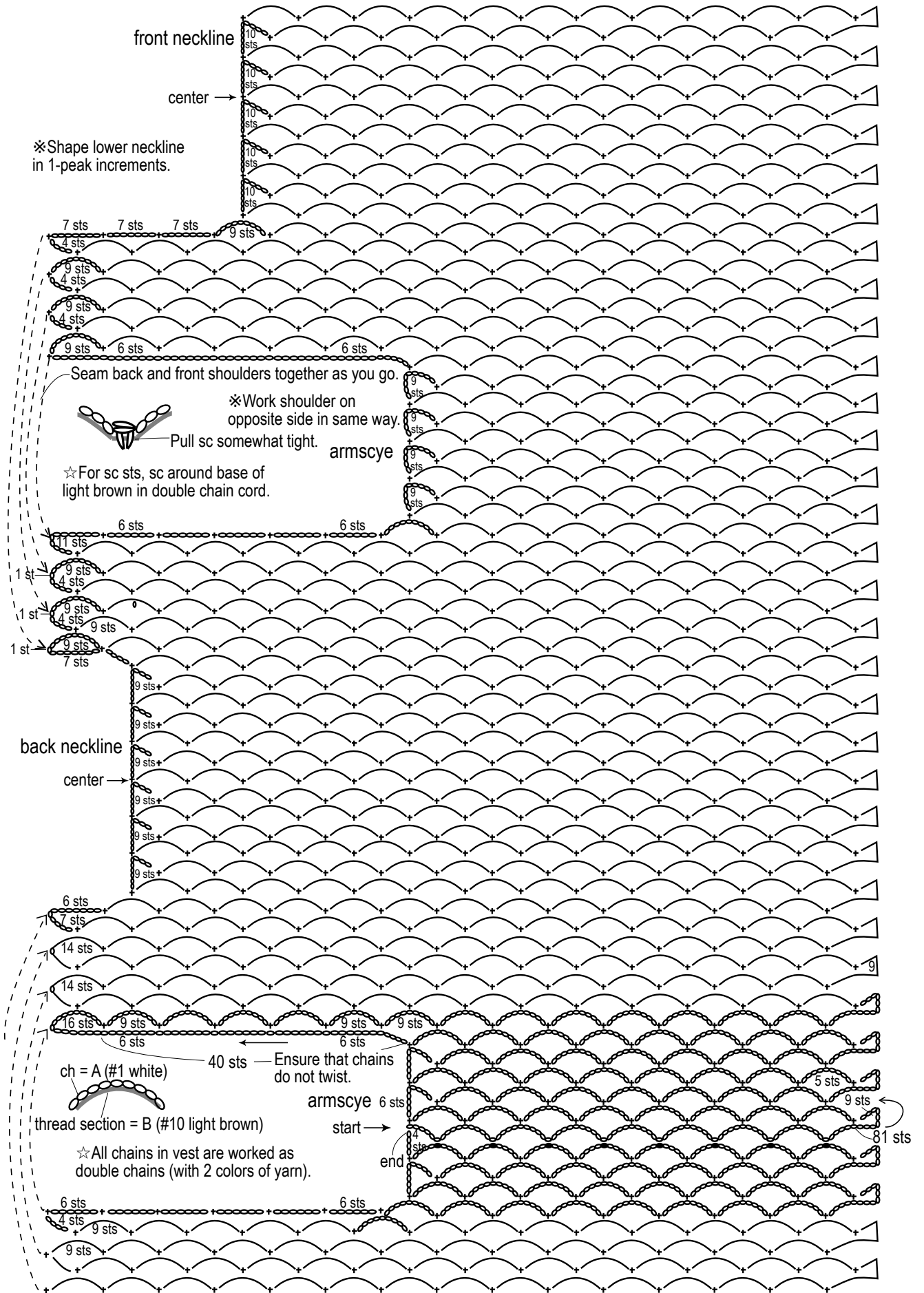
**Body:** Make a crochet double chain cord (ch81) to begin. Continue with ch9, and on next row, work sc into row below. Be sure not to twist the straight edges at armholes and neckline. On final row, seam first row to last row.

※Crochet the double chain with 2 colors.

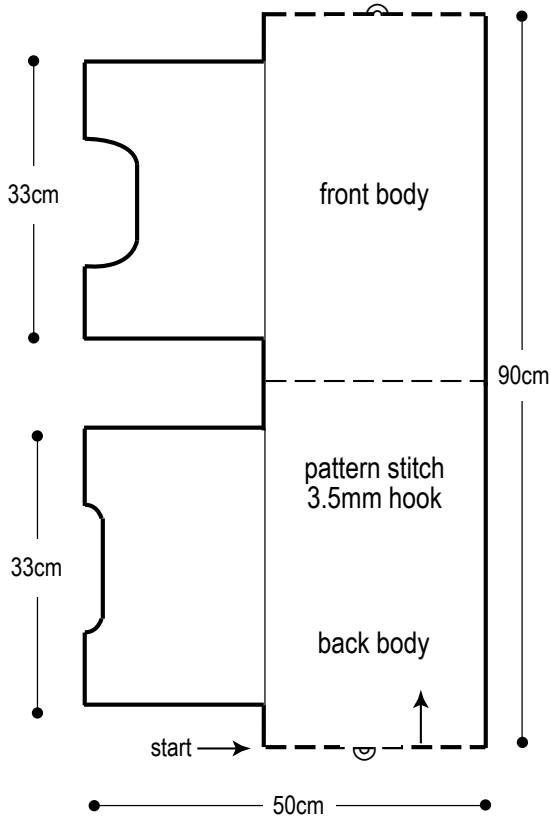
## Abbreviations:

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet (US)

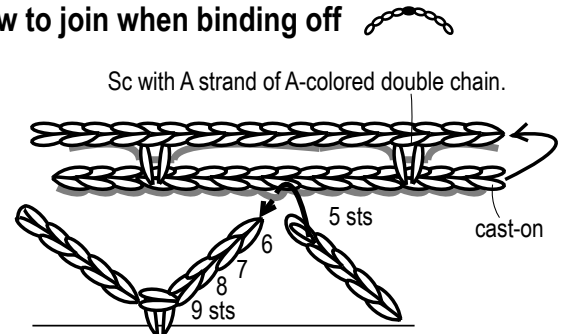
**Vest** (3.5mm hook)

## How to join when binding off

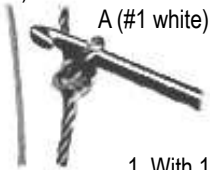


\*After working 5 sts, remove the hook and slip stitch from bottom to top. Work stitches 6, 7, 8, and 9. Sc into previous row.

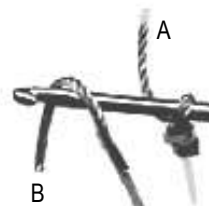
## Crochet double chain instructions (3.5mm hook)

Crocheted with 2 strands in 2 different colors.

B (#10 light brown)



1. With 1 strand of #1 white and 1 strand of #10 light brown, crochet double chain as follows: Work chain stitch with color #1, then place color #10 over hook.



2. Lay color #10 over hook from front to back as shown.



3. With #10 light brown in the middle, work a normal chain stitch with #1 white.



4. With #10 light brown in the middle, repeat steps 2-3.
